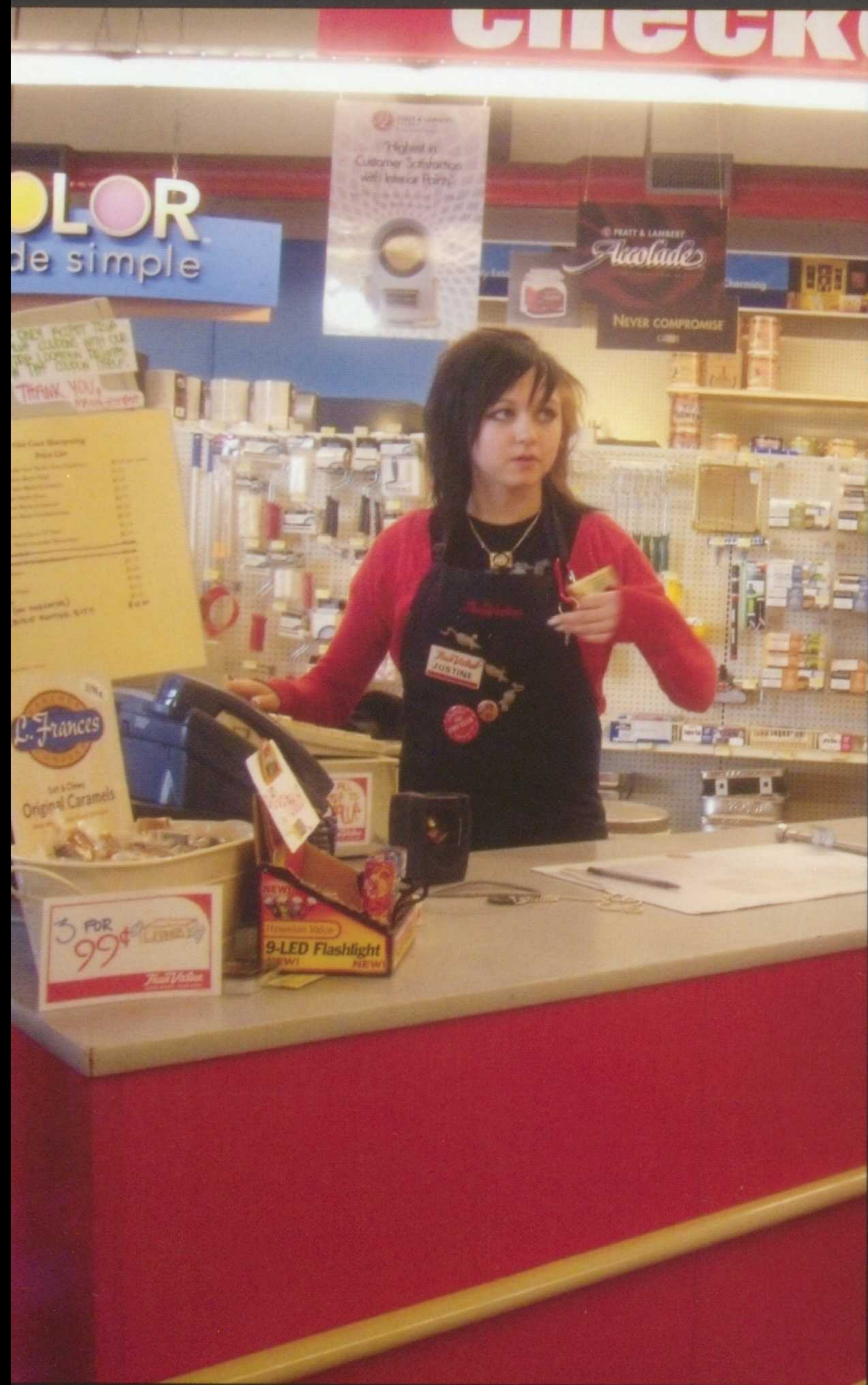
Relay For Life

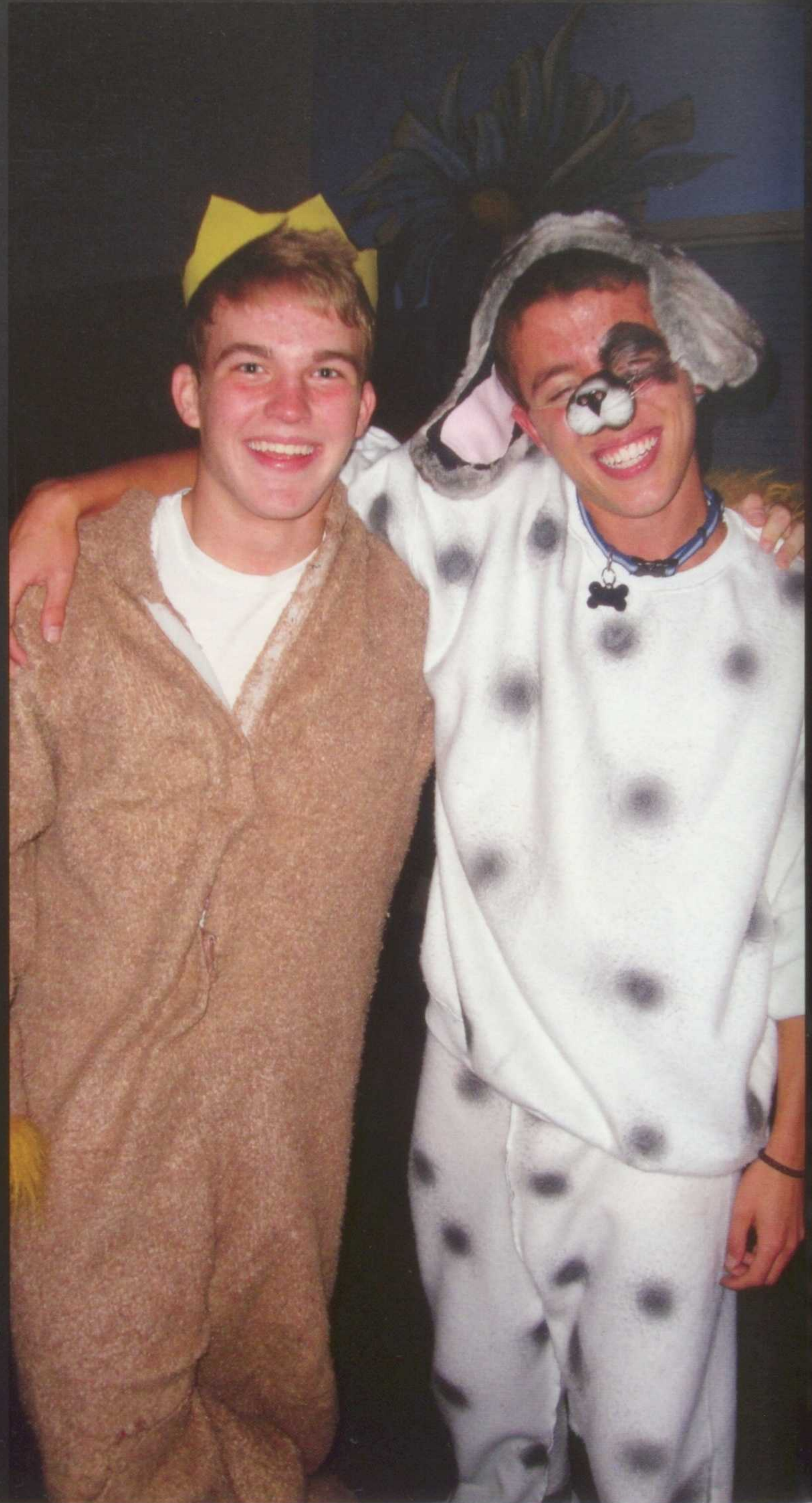

First, he was the director, who oversaw every detail to make each performance a success. Jim created and/ or ran different volunteer groups to better the community. Whether it was HUDDLE, YPF, or Relay for Life, he tried to make sure that everything ran smoothly and easily for the cast of Bay Village. He led the students, so they would continuously volunteer in the community and other schools. And, when it appeared that he couldn't run another activity, he then created a new Bullying Seminar at Bay High School, so the students could become better people. Like a good director, he led, and the cast followed his lead.

Then, he played the part of the quiet assistant, who gently ensured that all of the ground work was completed well for every project. He wrote essays for the Blue Ribbon School Award, so that Bay could achieve the highest honor it deserved. He attended sporting events, music performances and class fundraisers to ensure that students would see his support. And, in all these events, he would quietly stand at the side-lines, watching and encouraging all of the students, so they could find success.
