Lit Mag



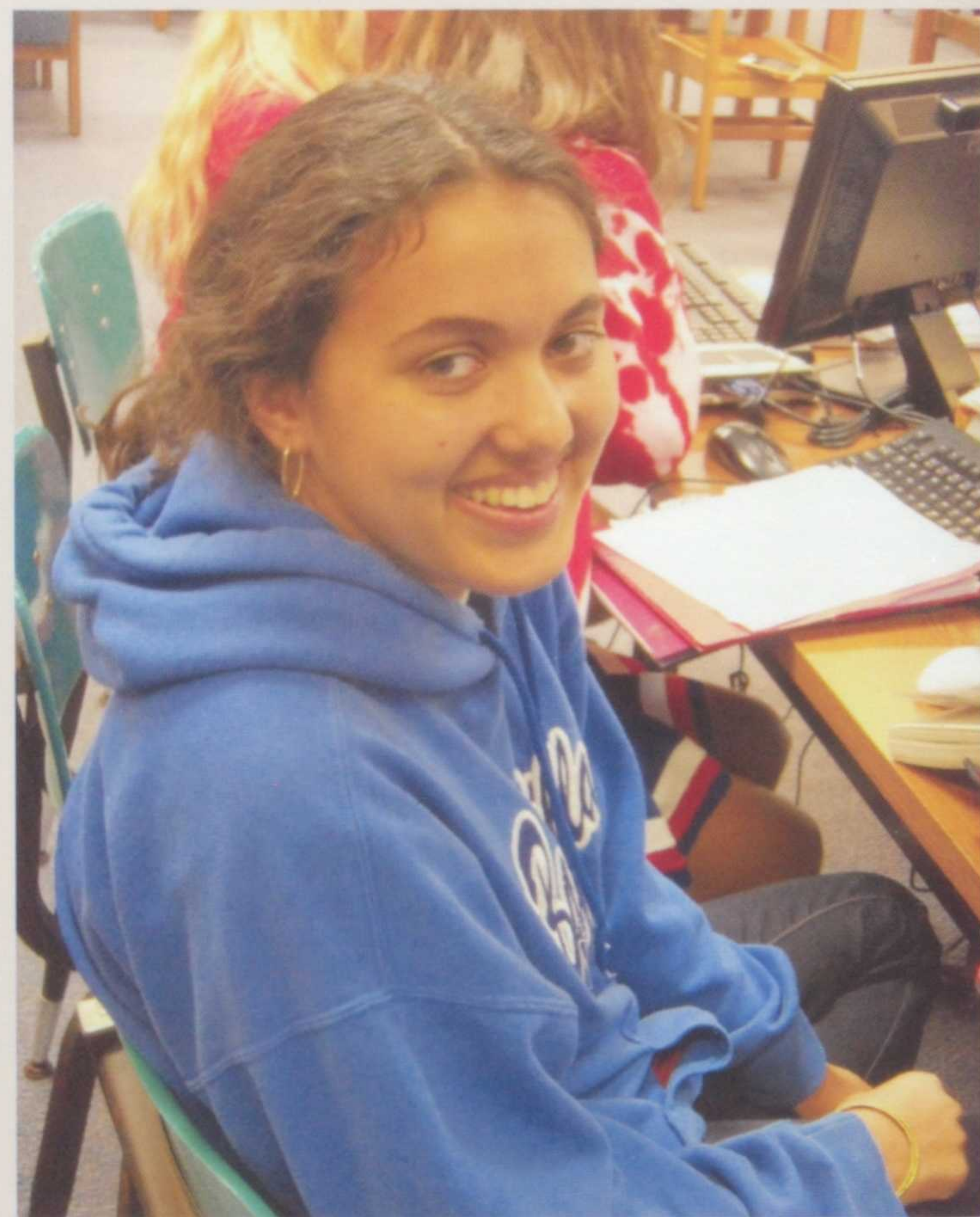
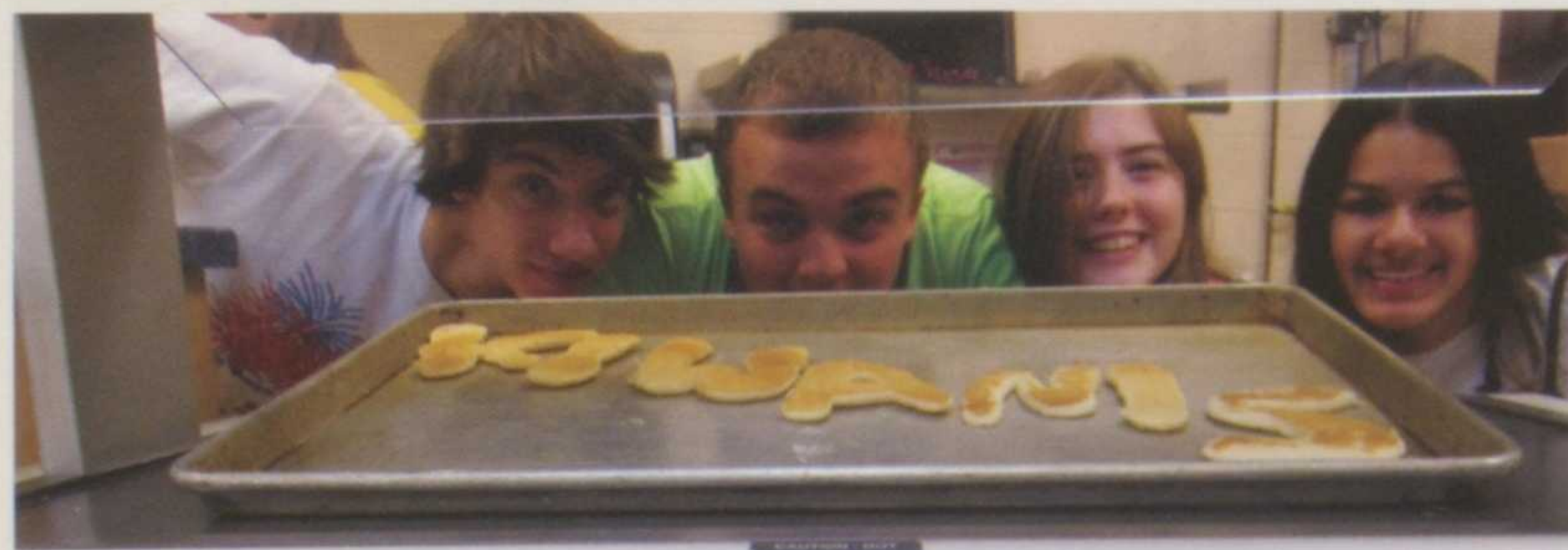

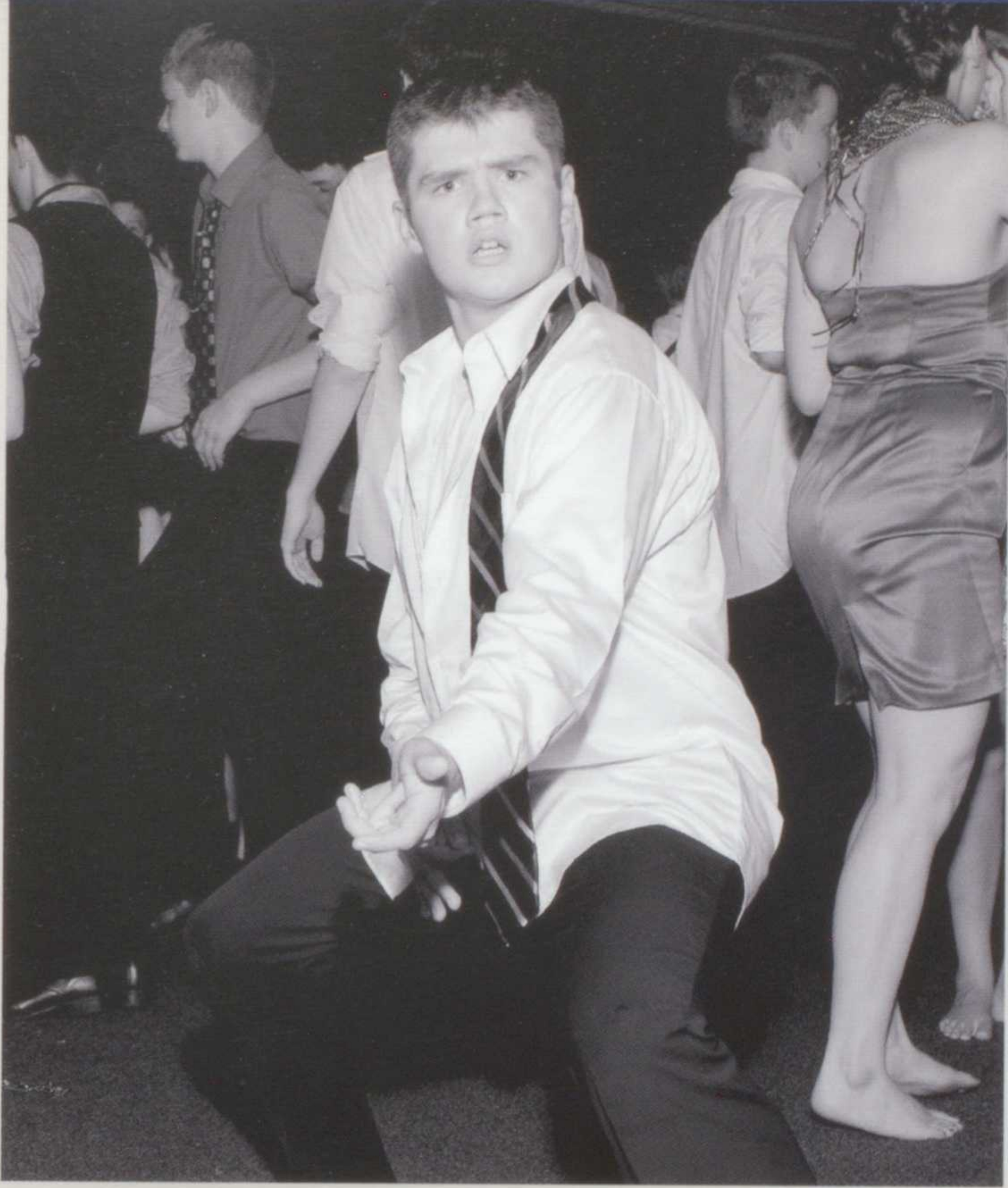

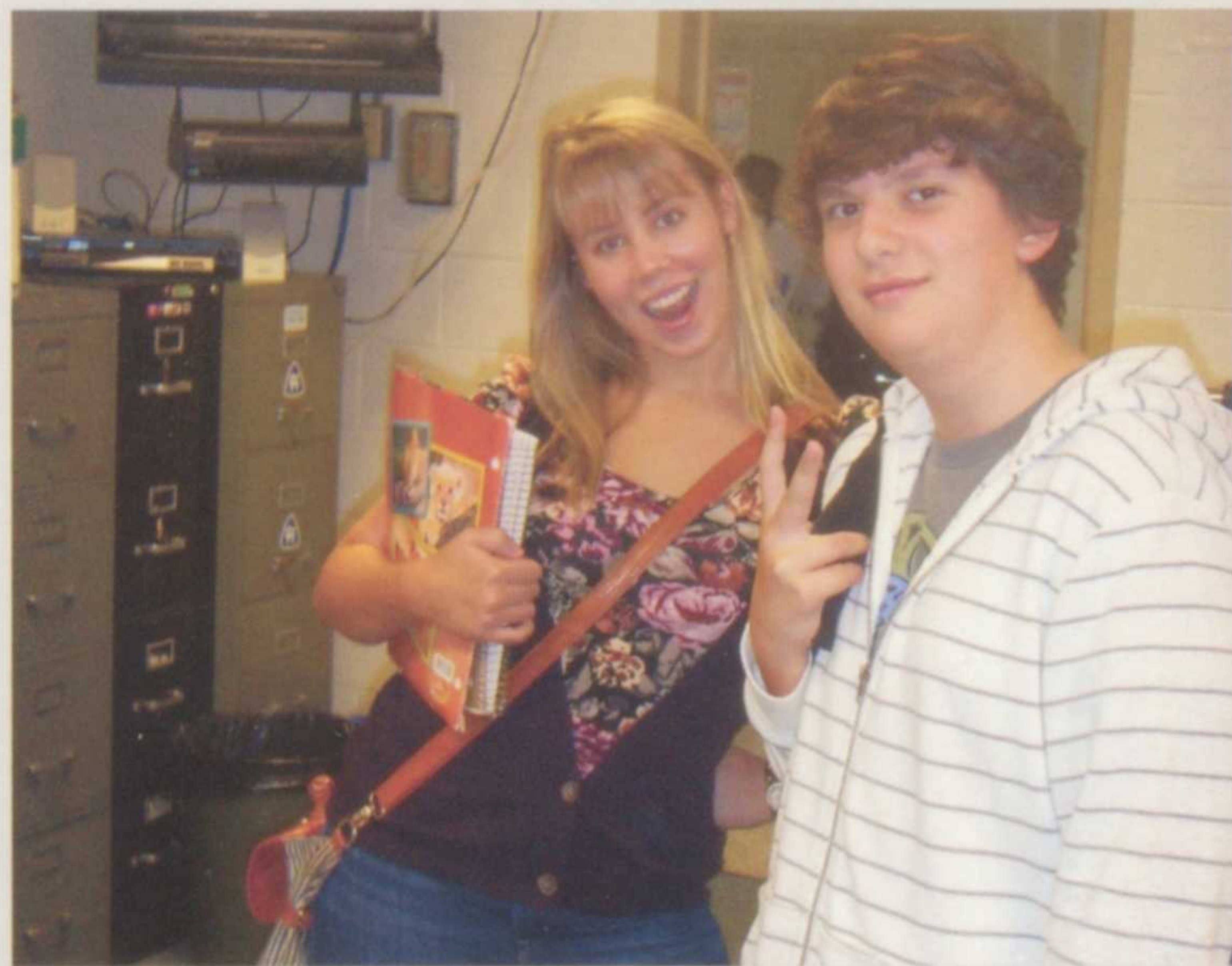

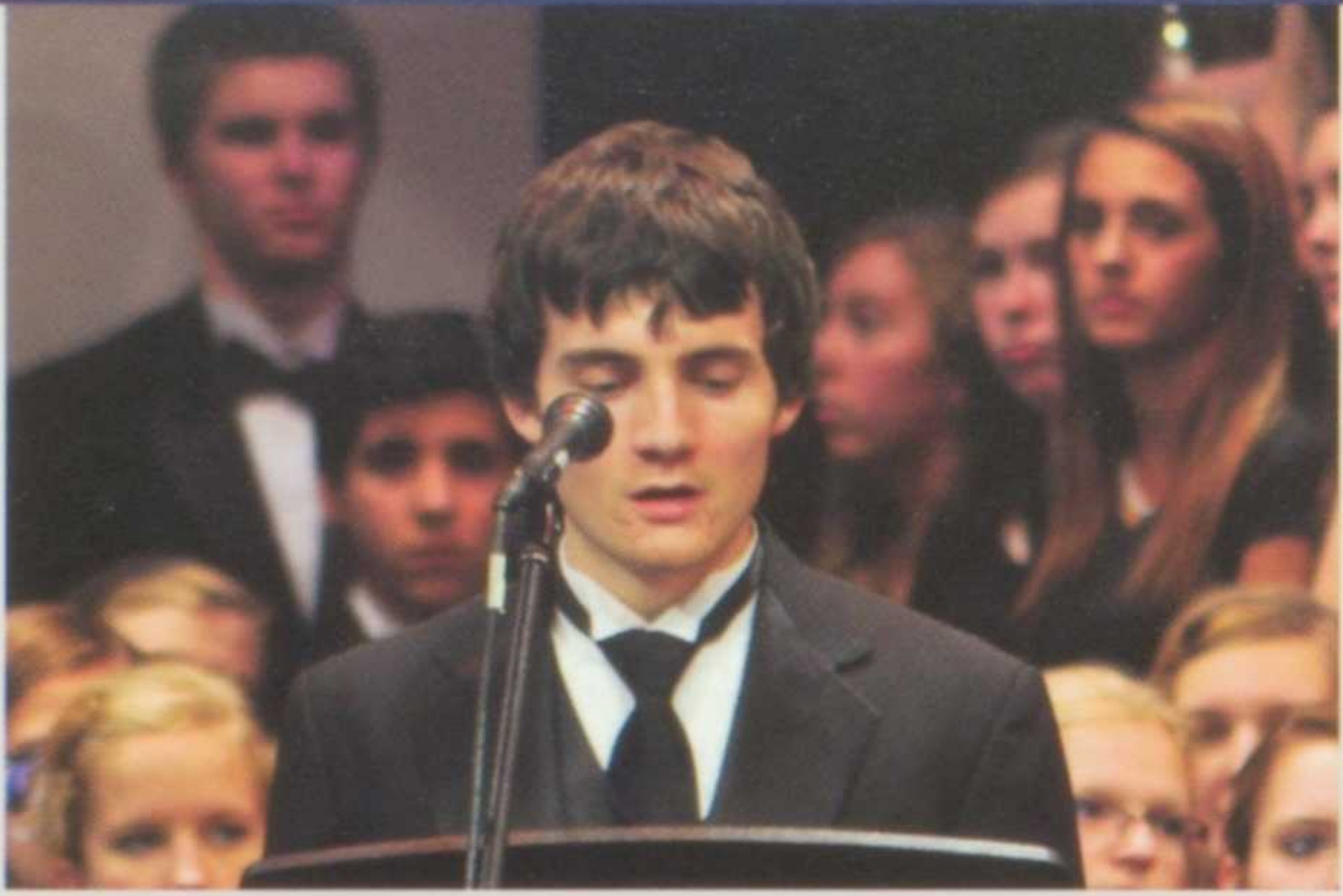

Window



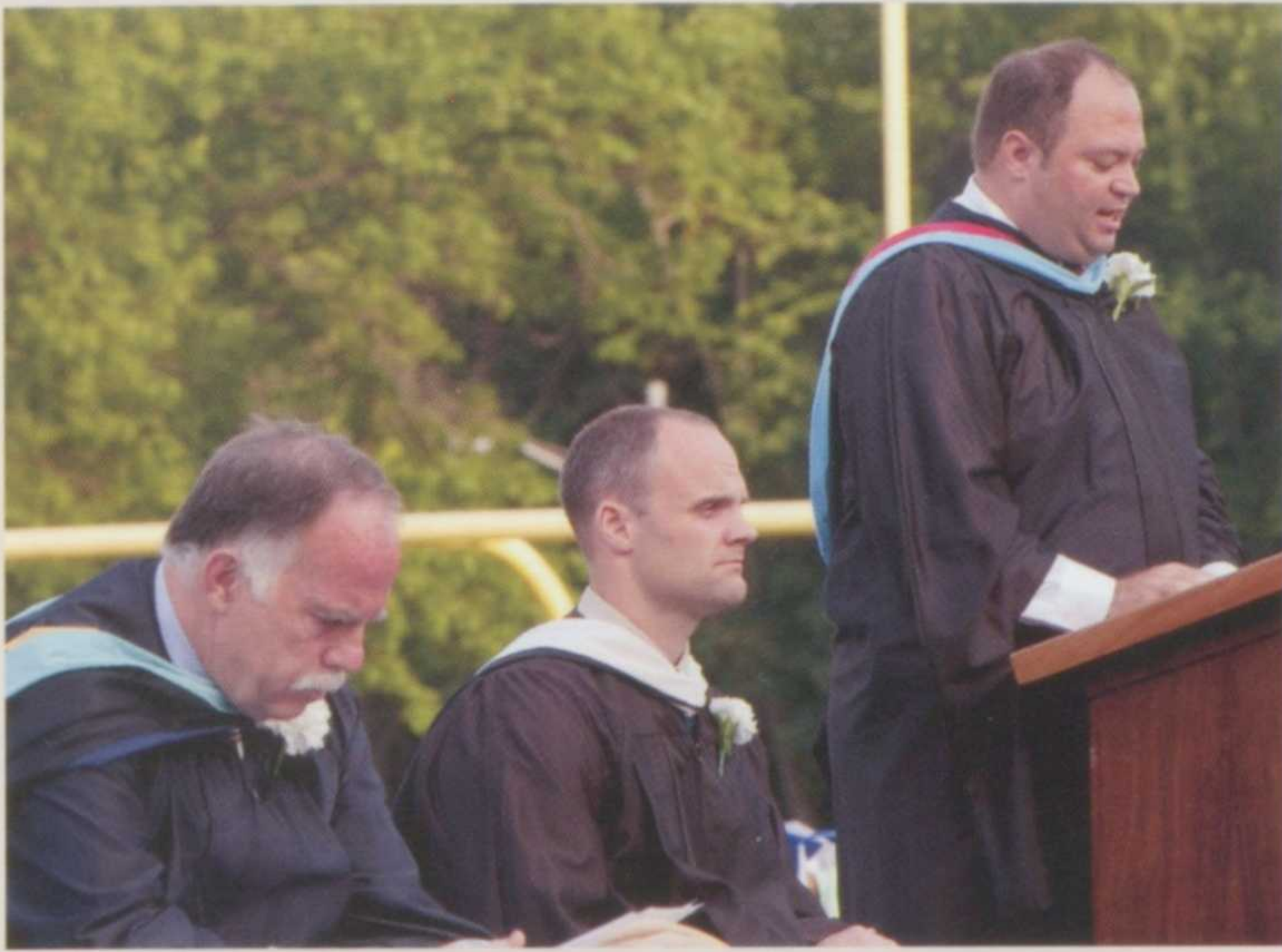

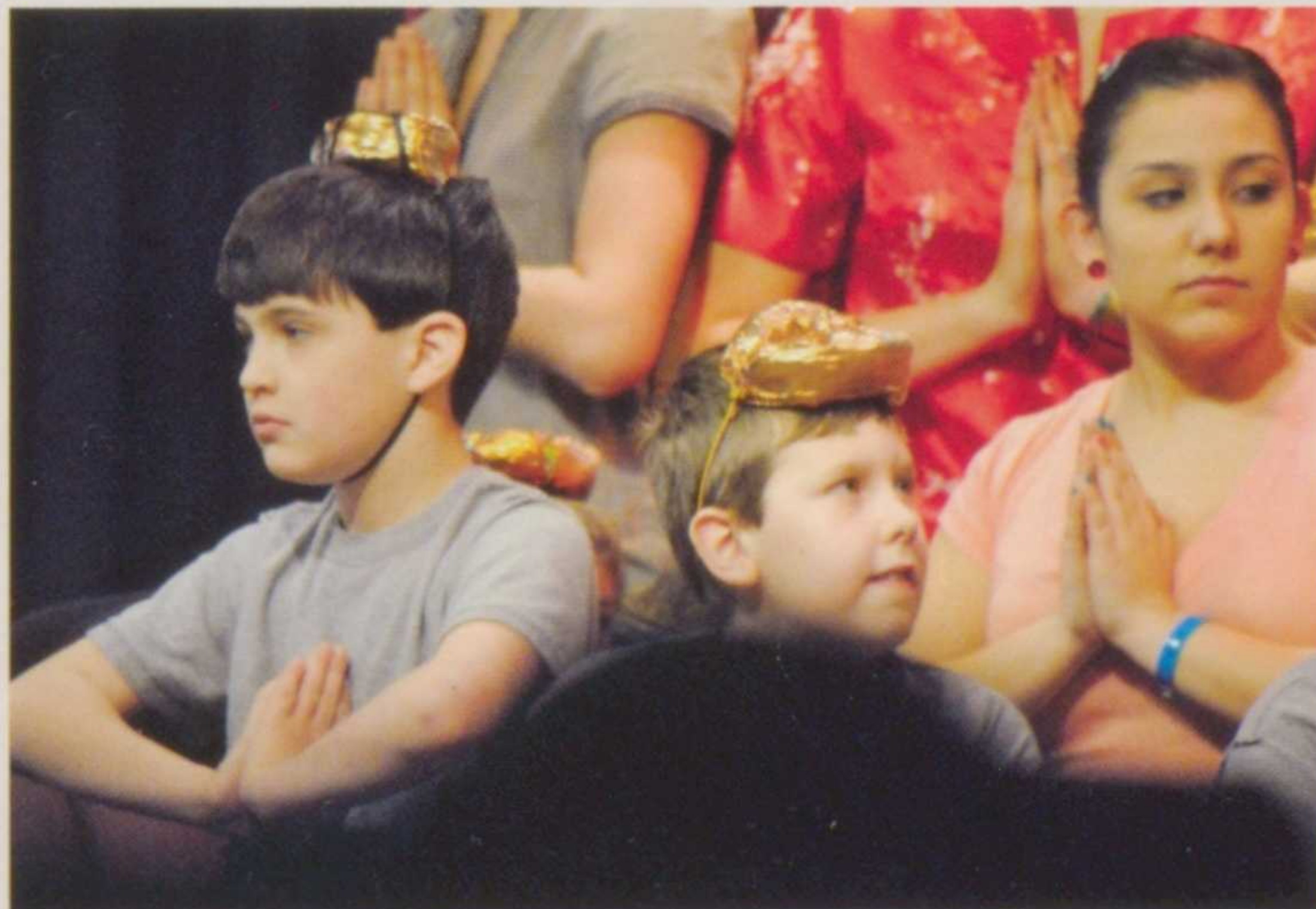

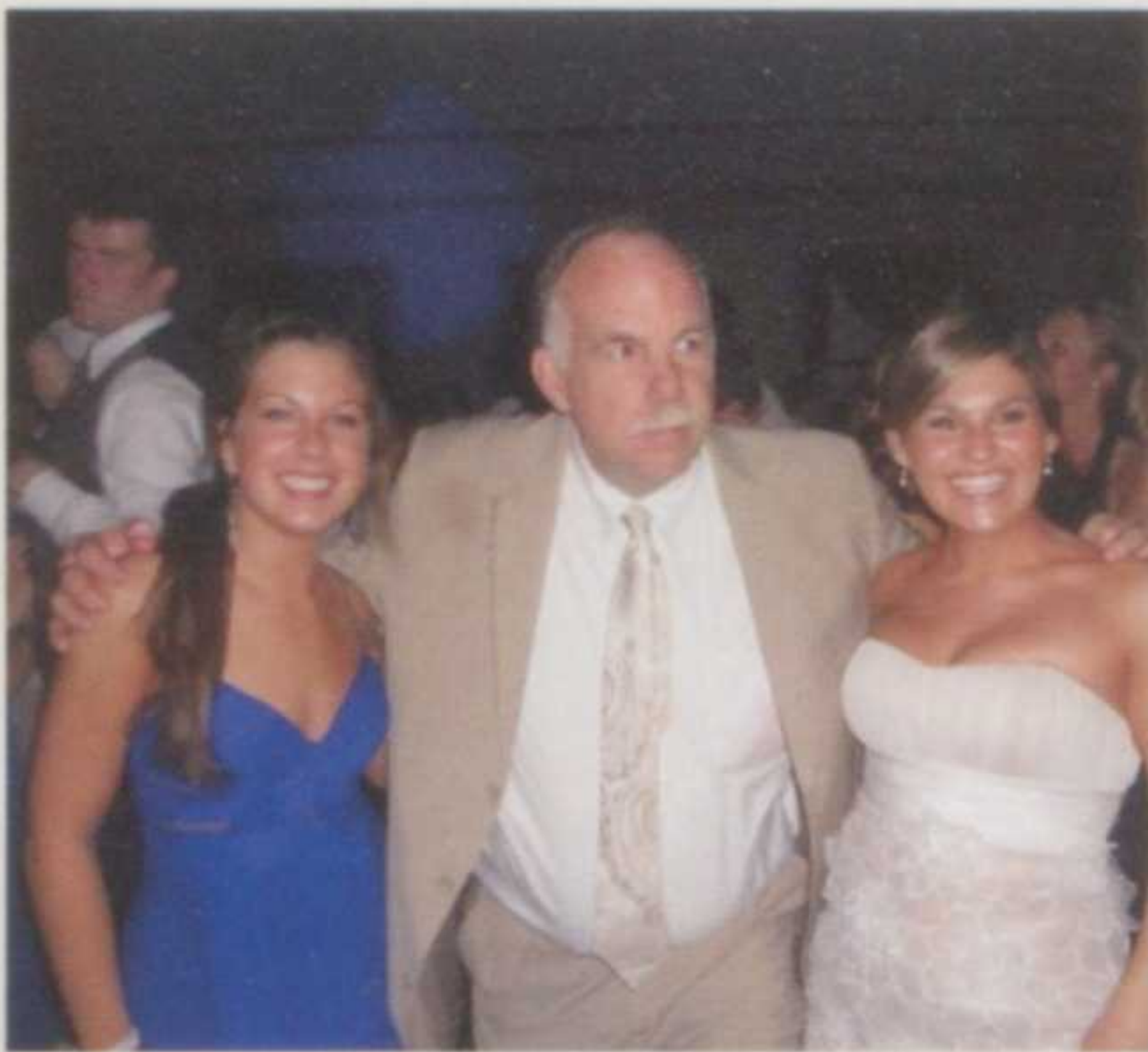

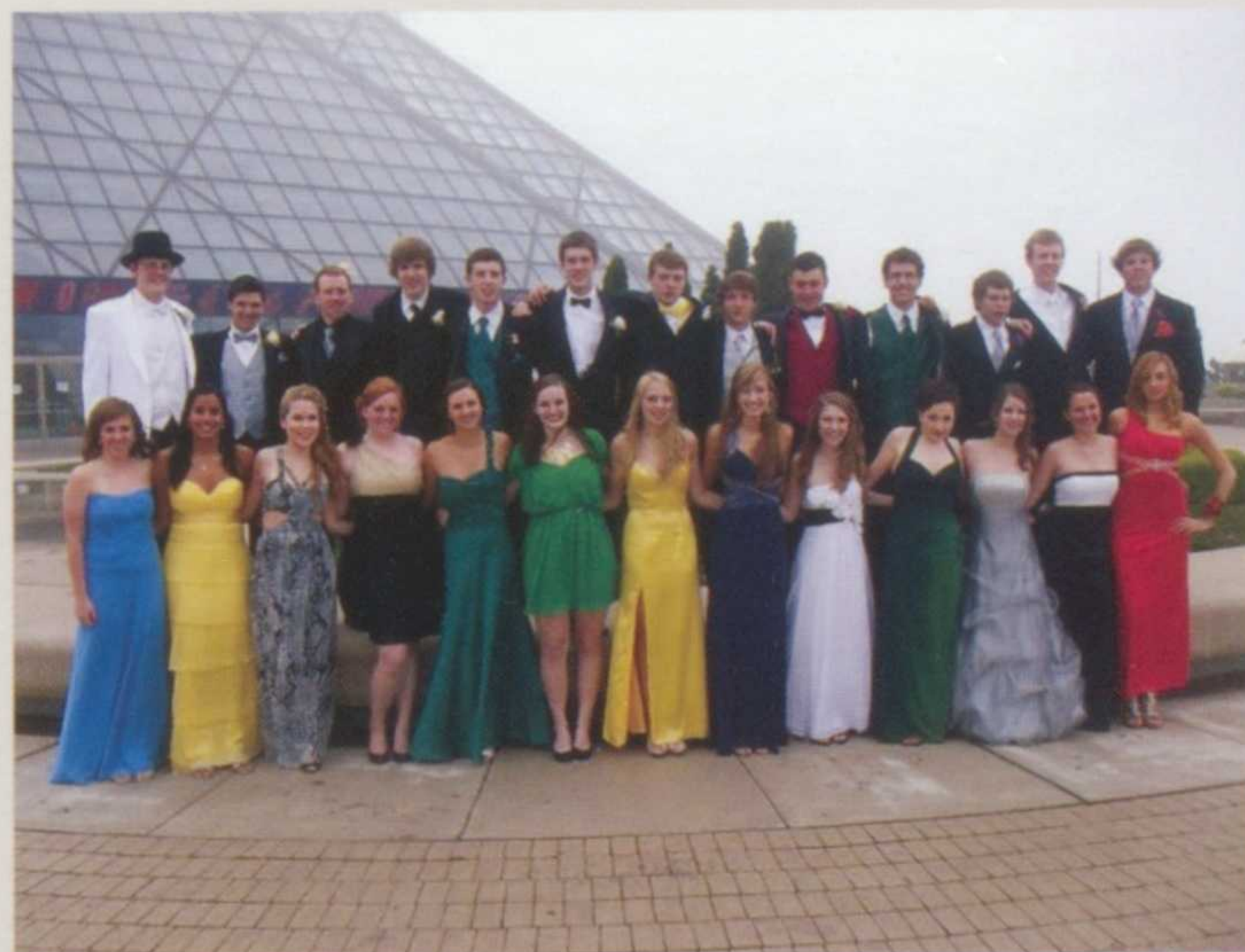

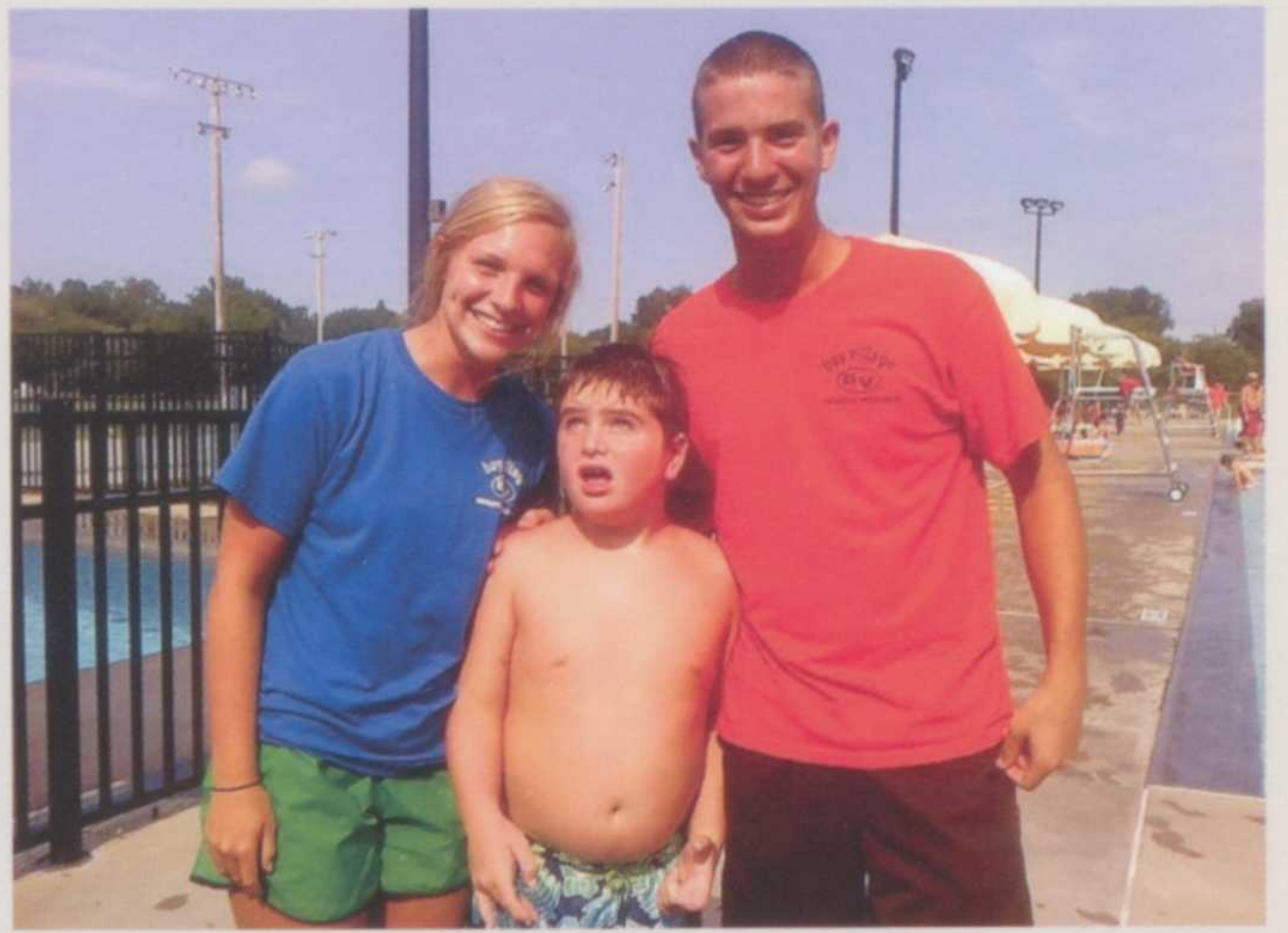

Relay for Life

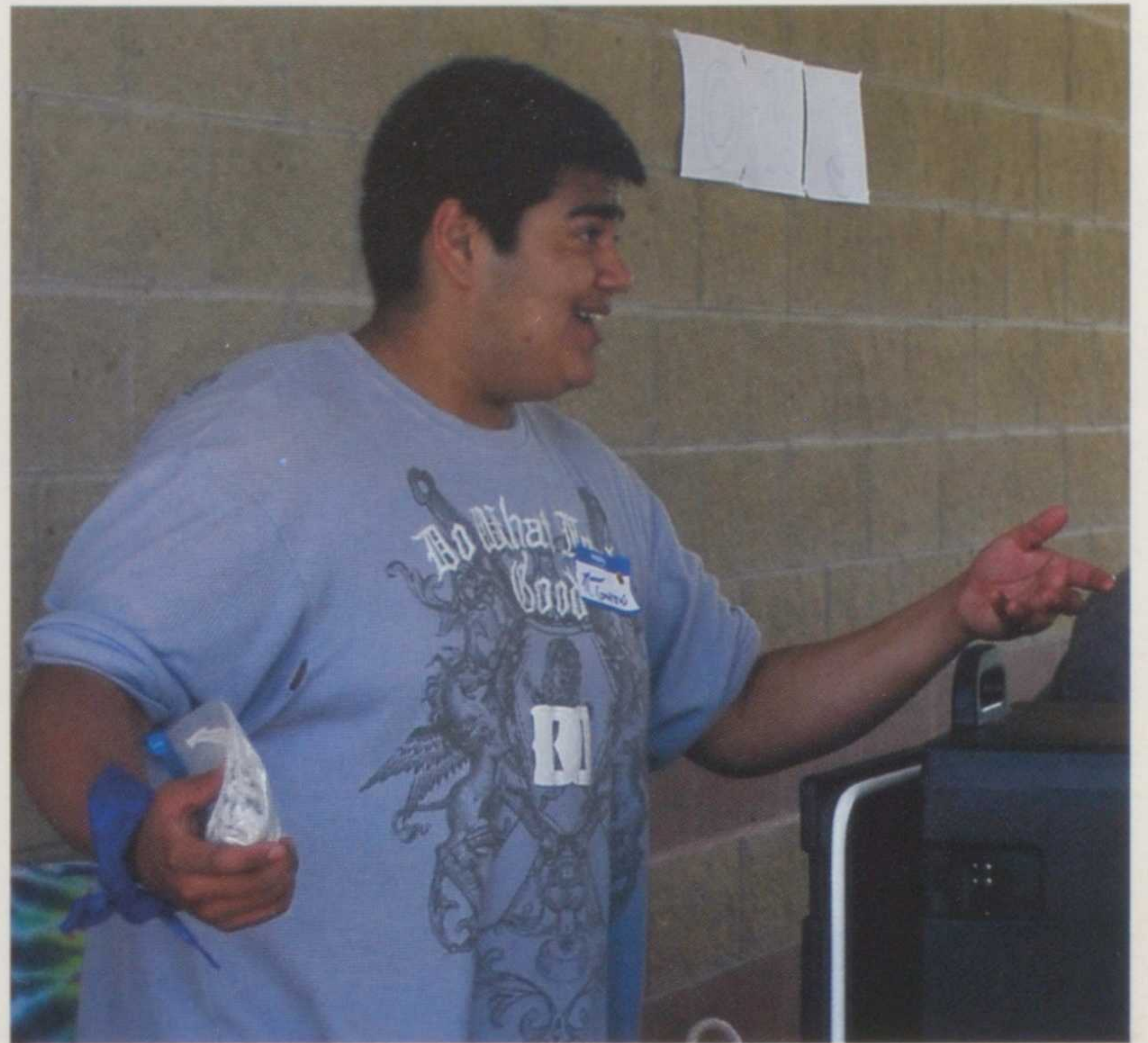

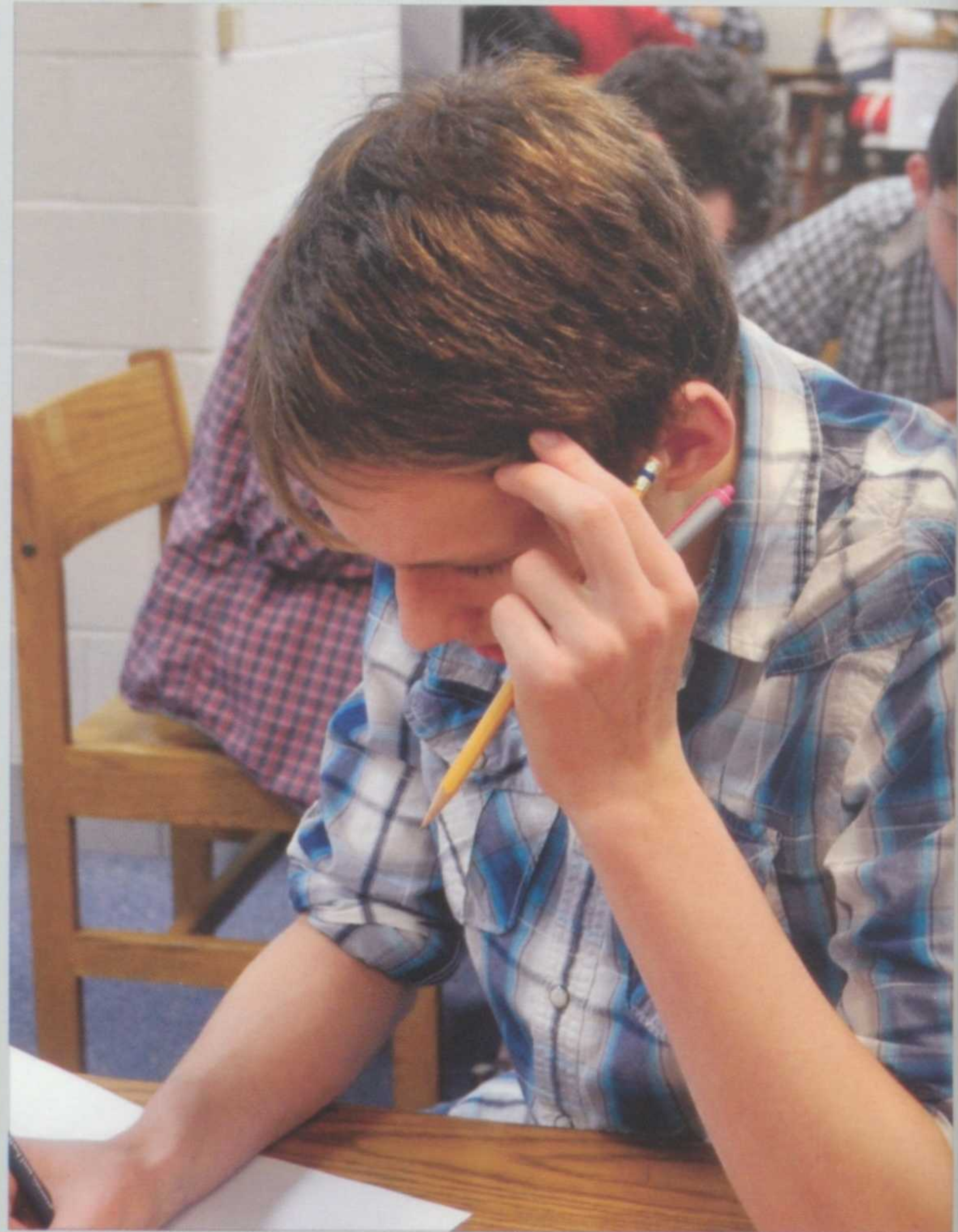

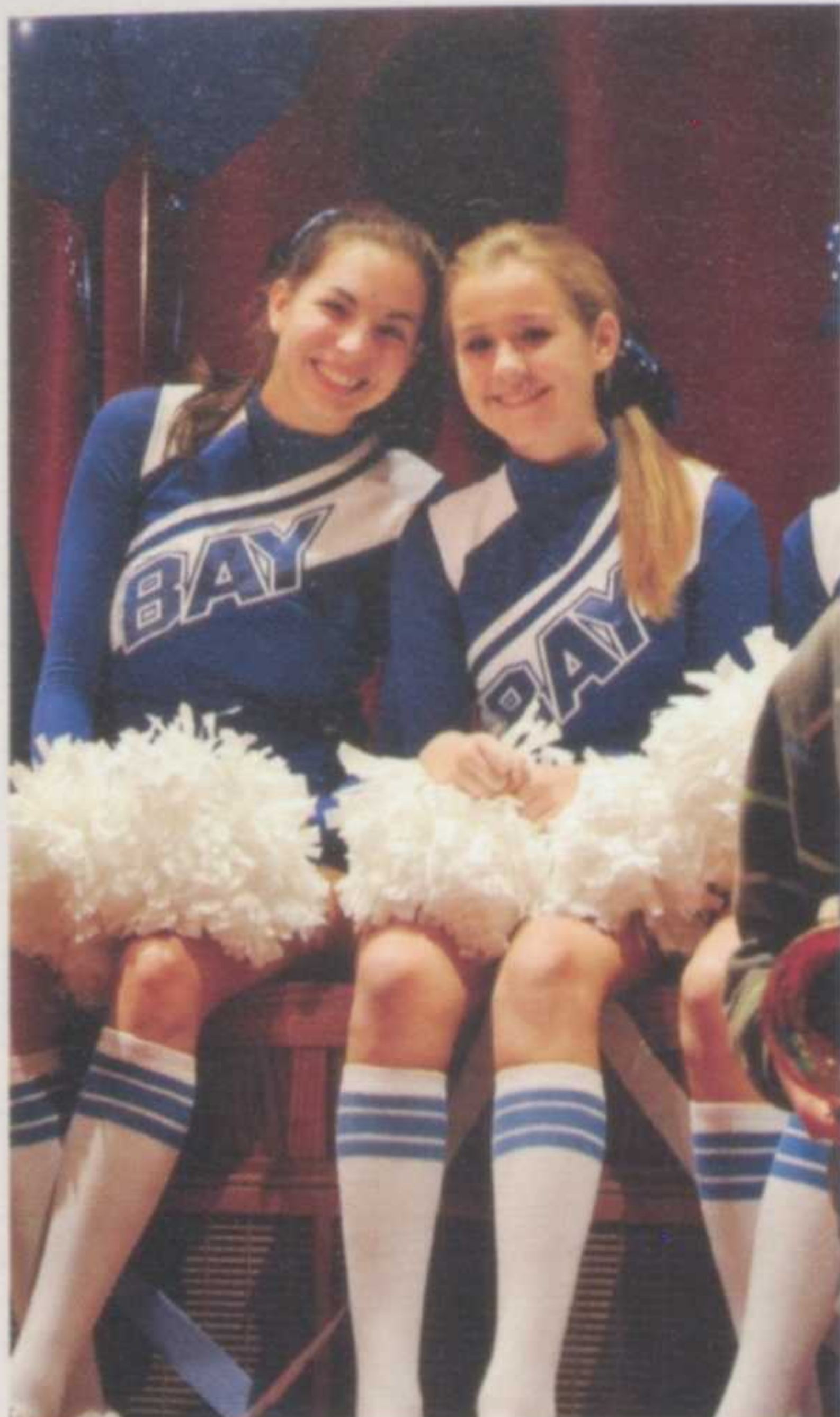

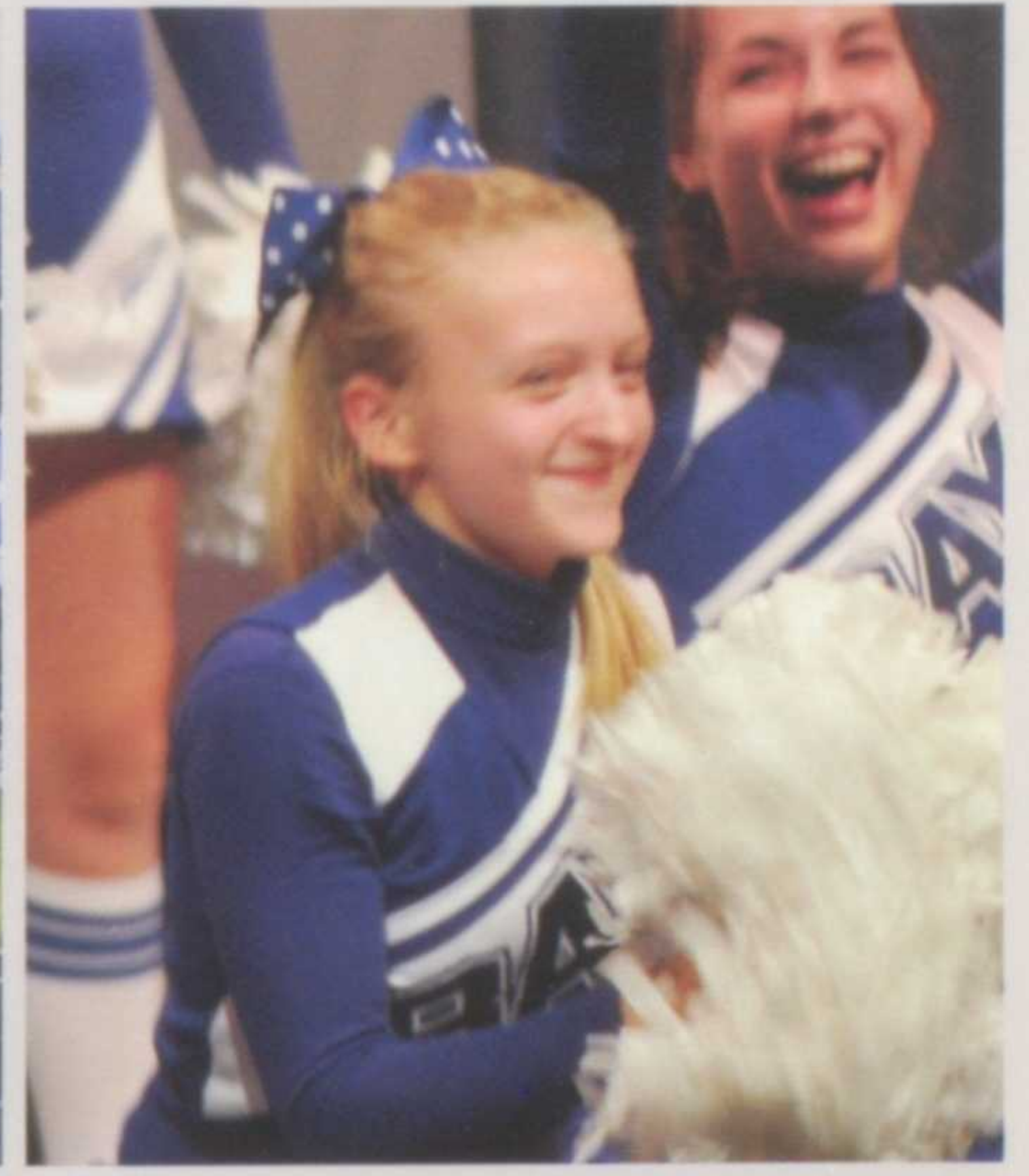

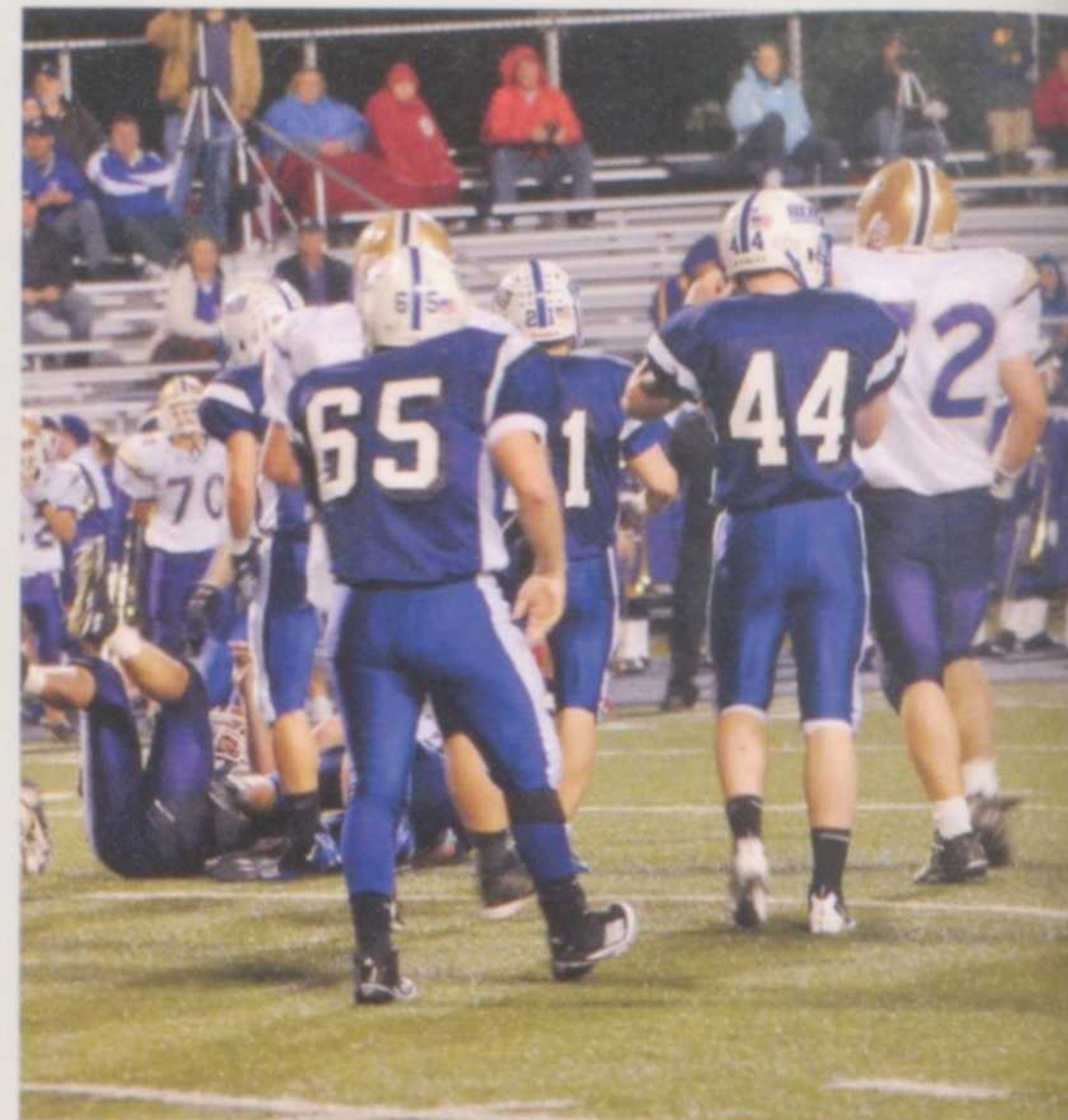


Above: The Senior players stand upon the auditorium stage. They are the first class to beat Rocky River in 9 years.

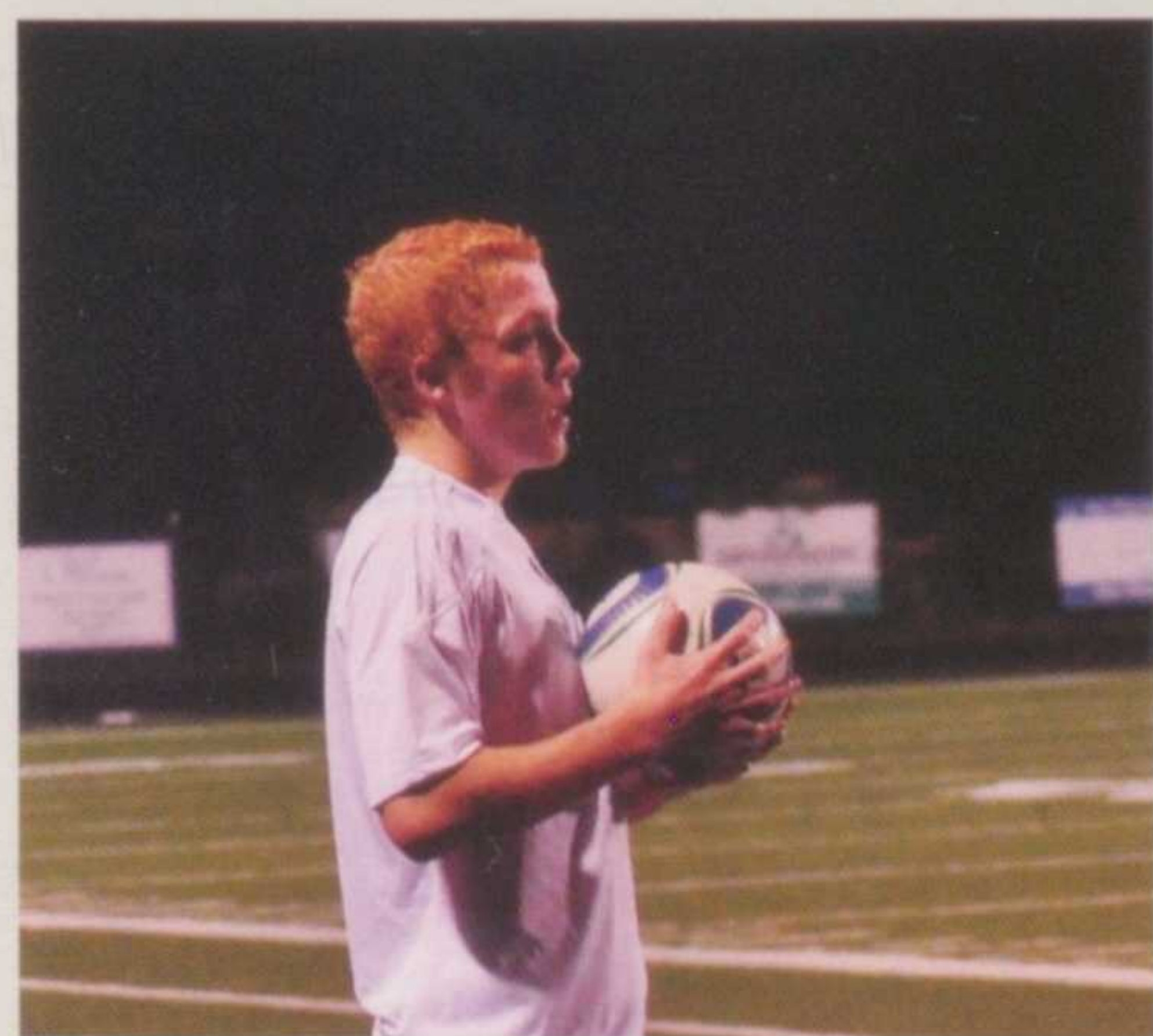
Boys Soccer

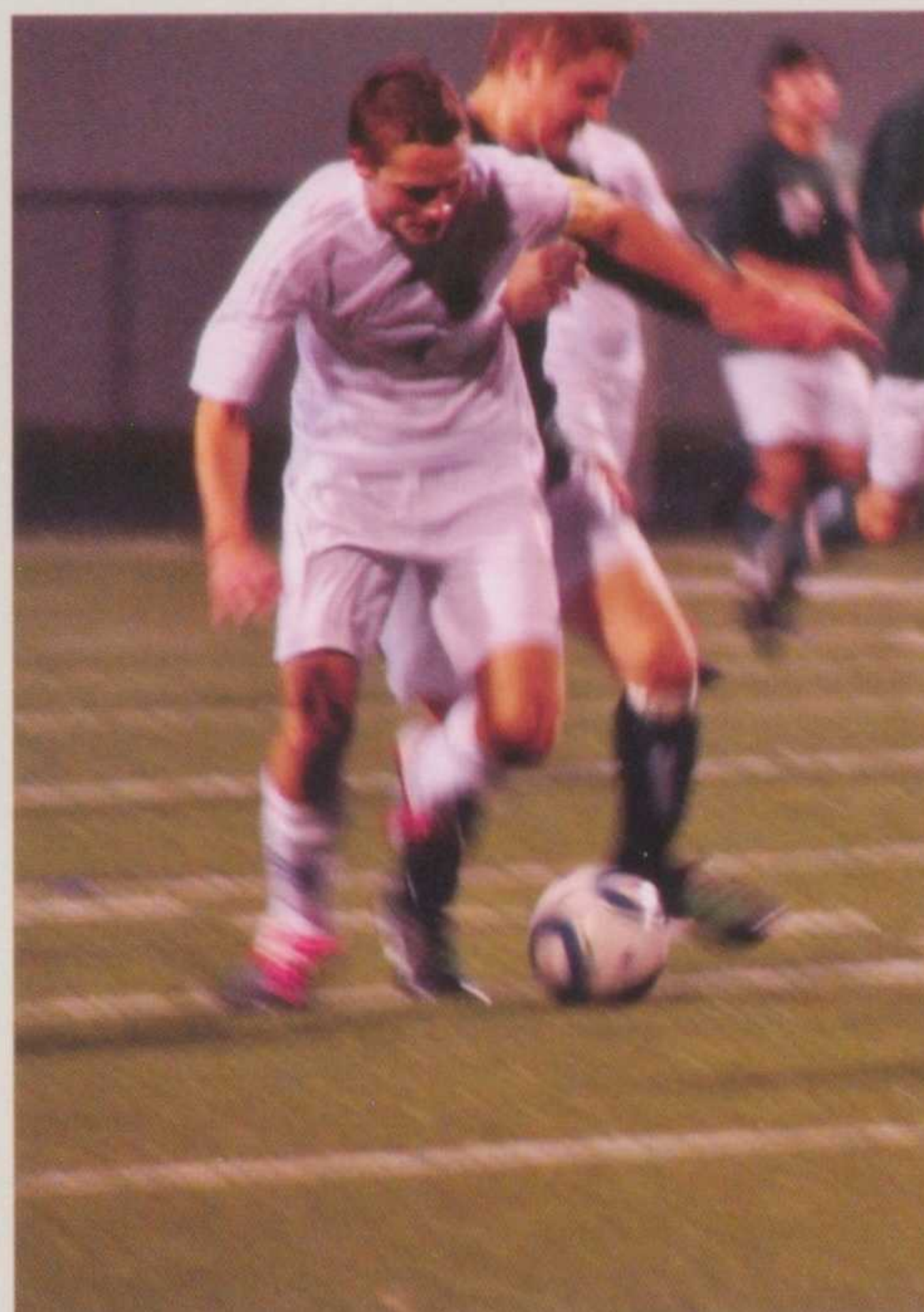

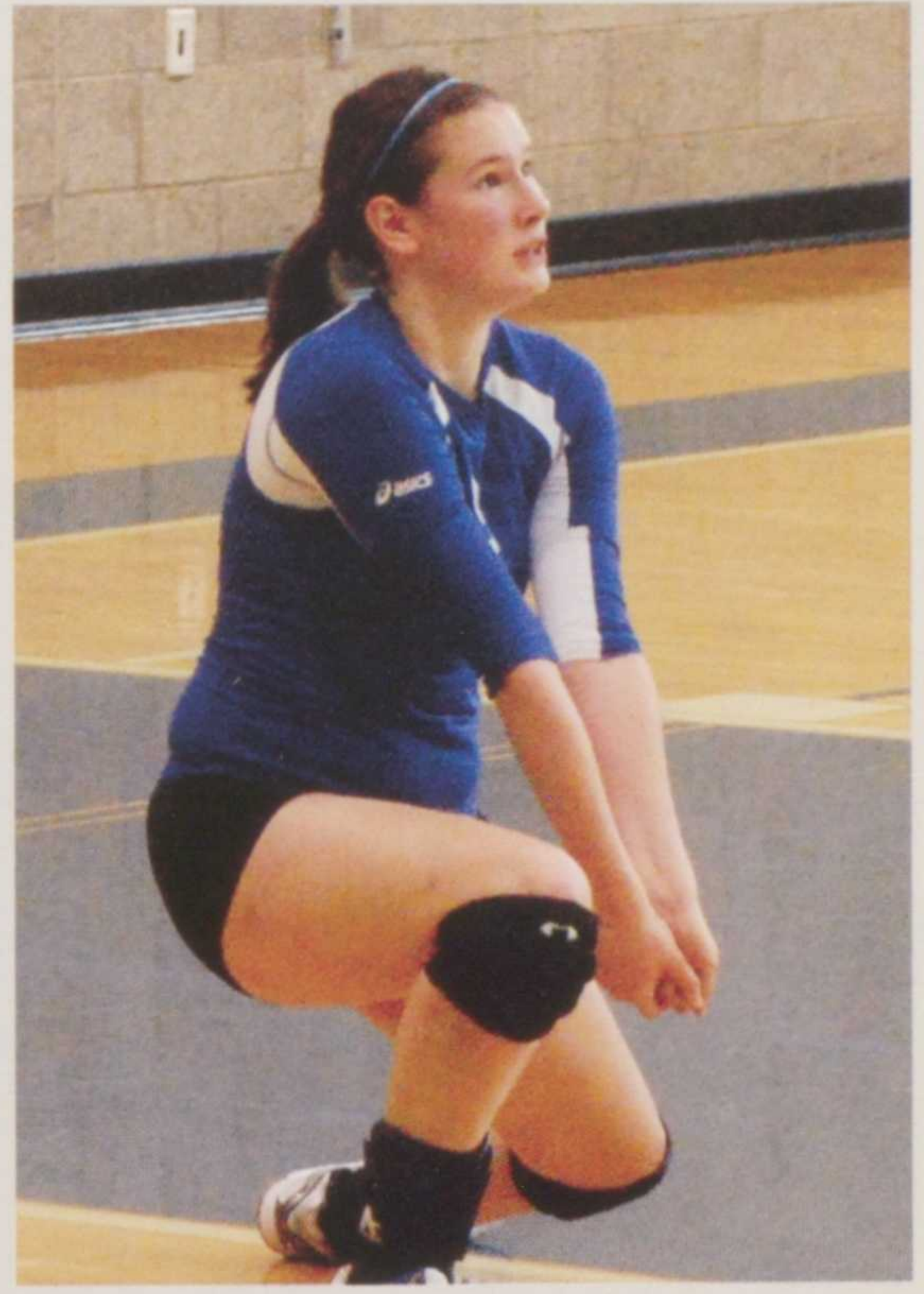

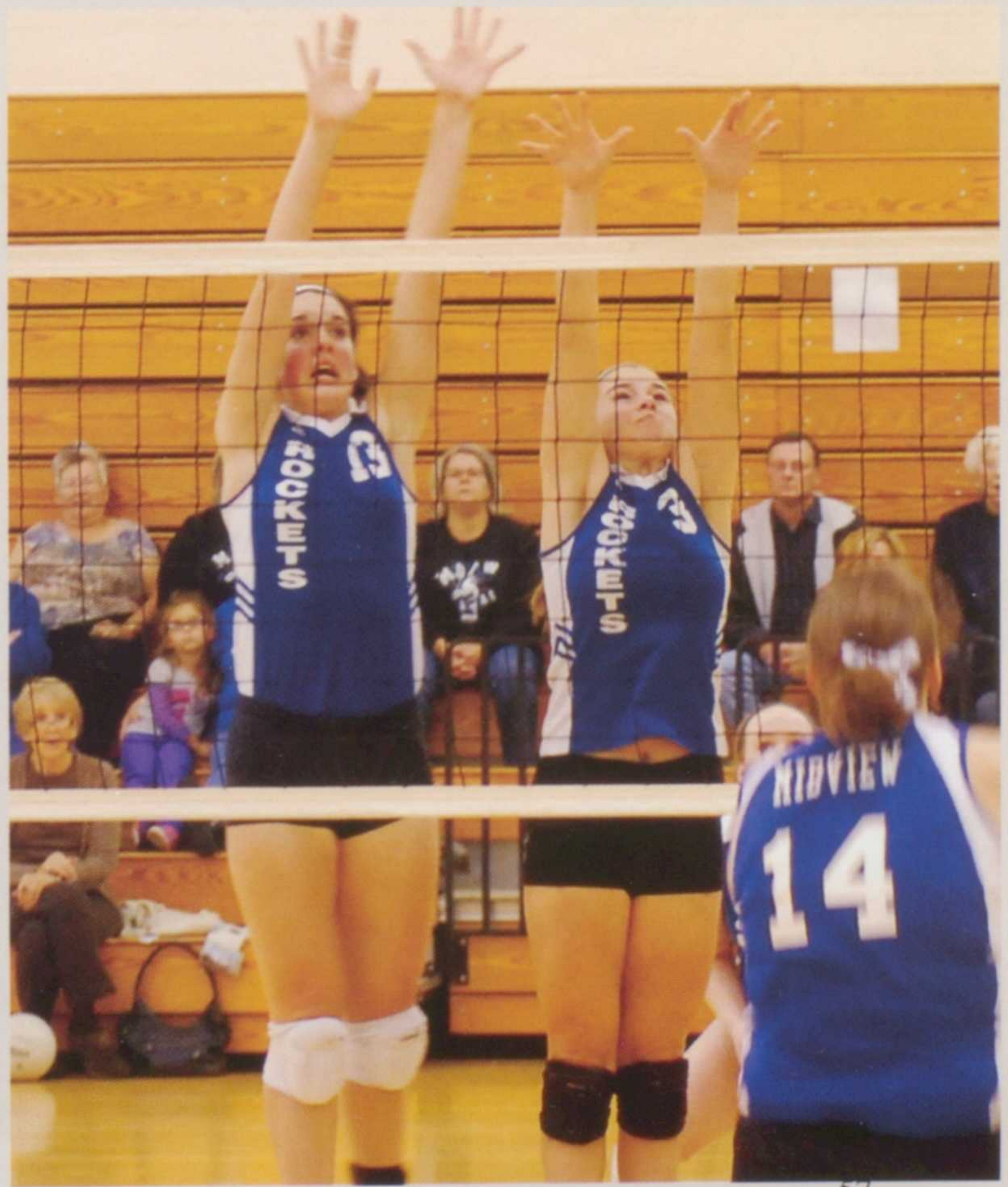

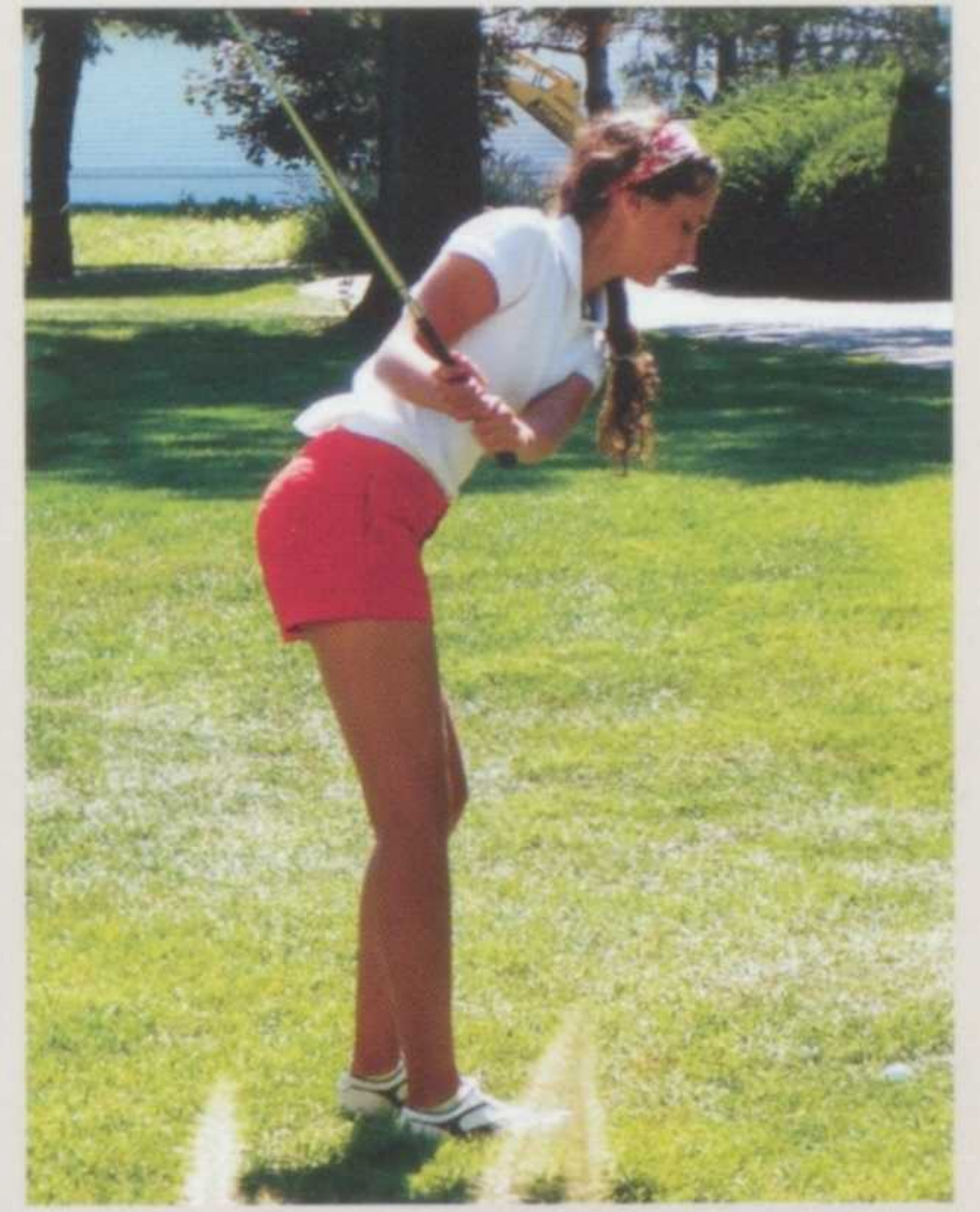

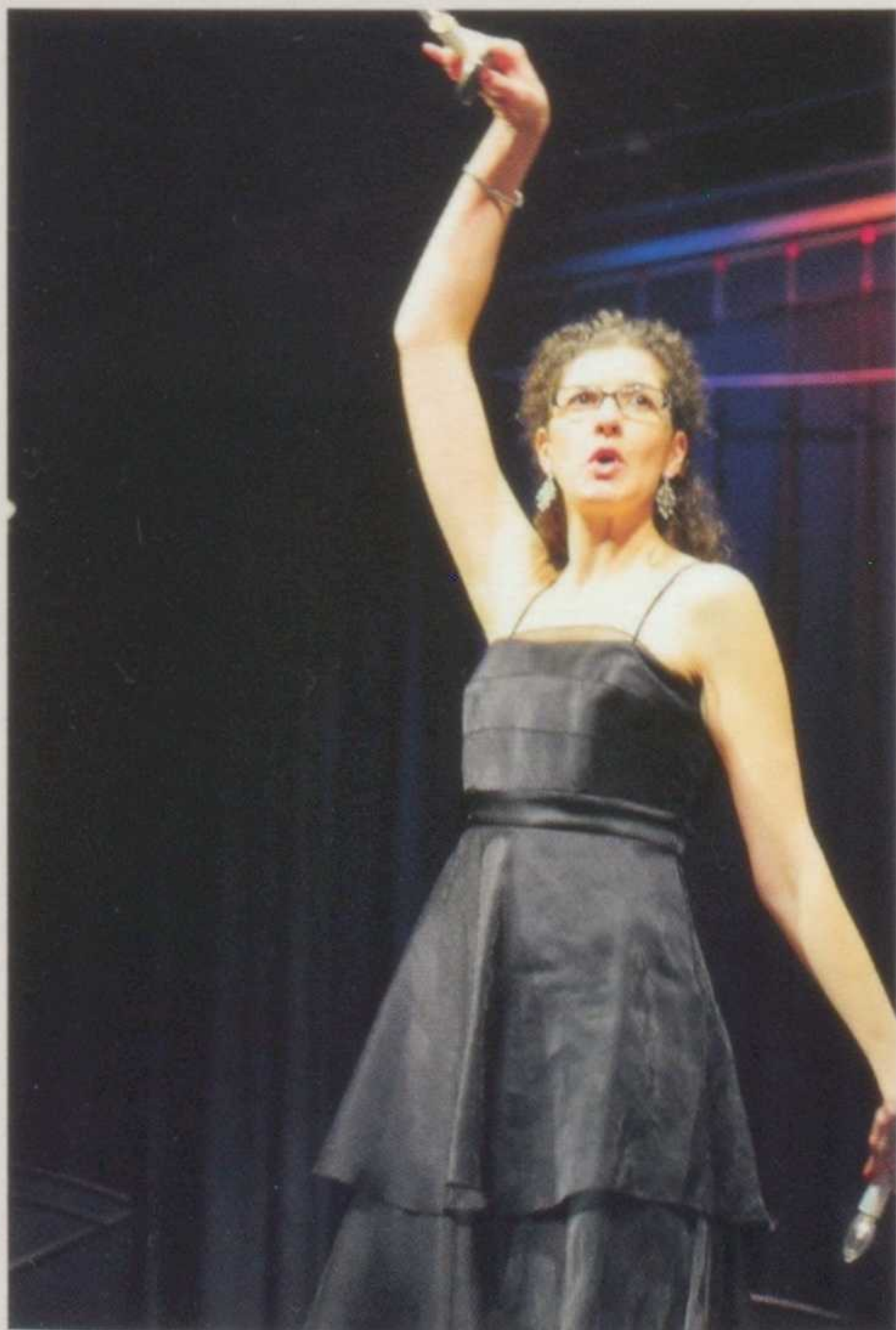
Holidays

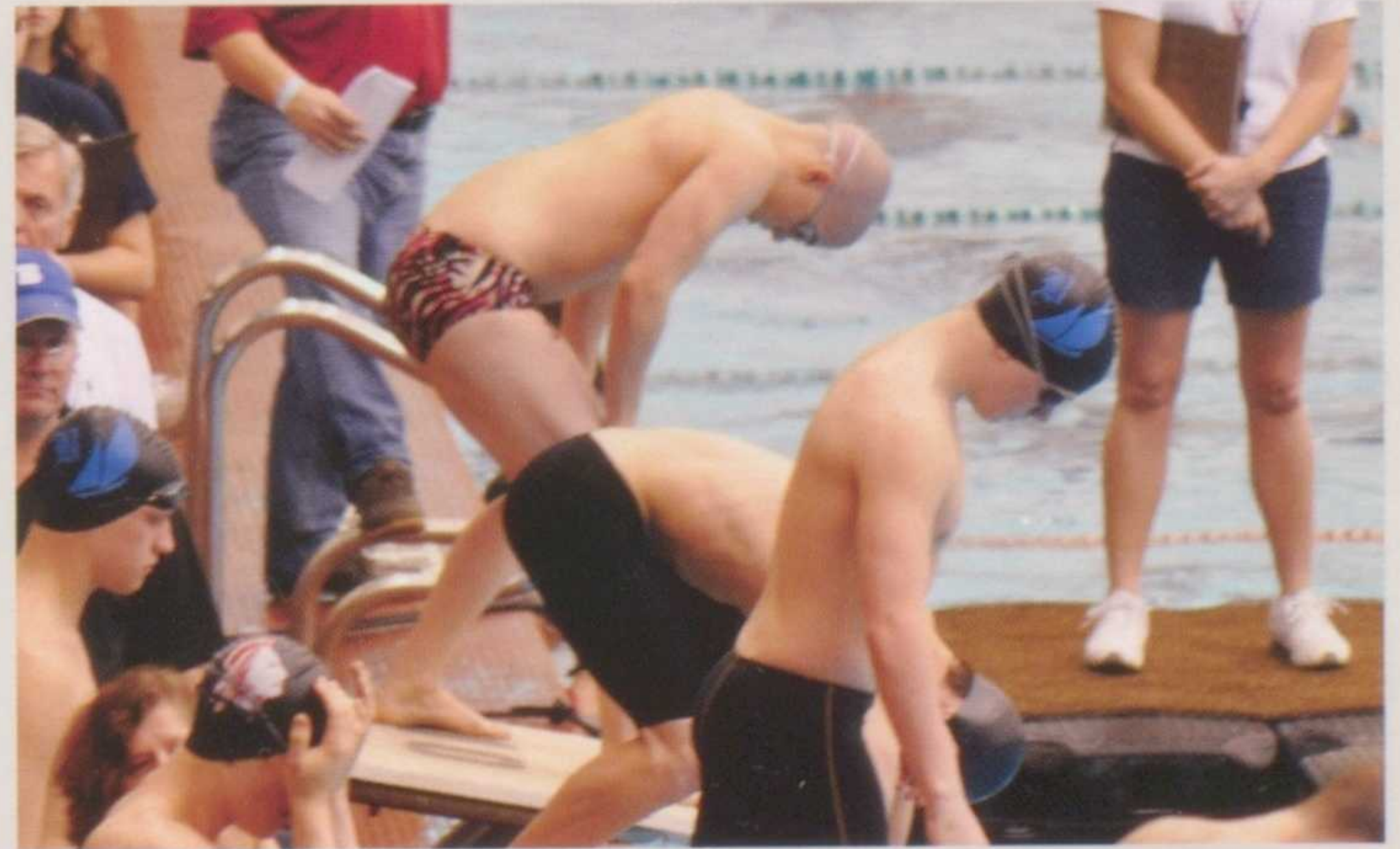

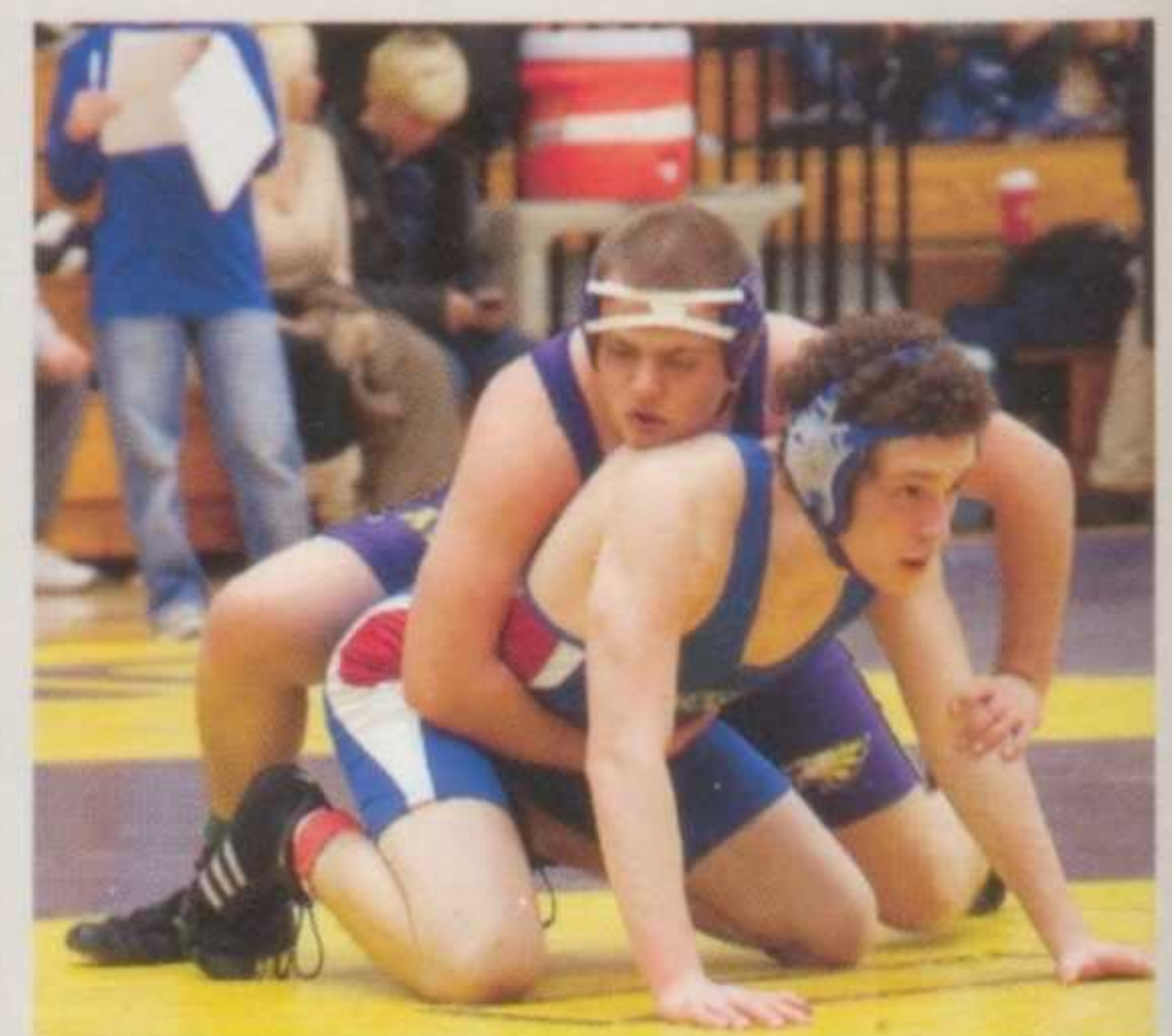
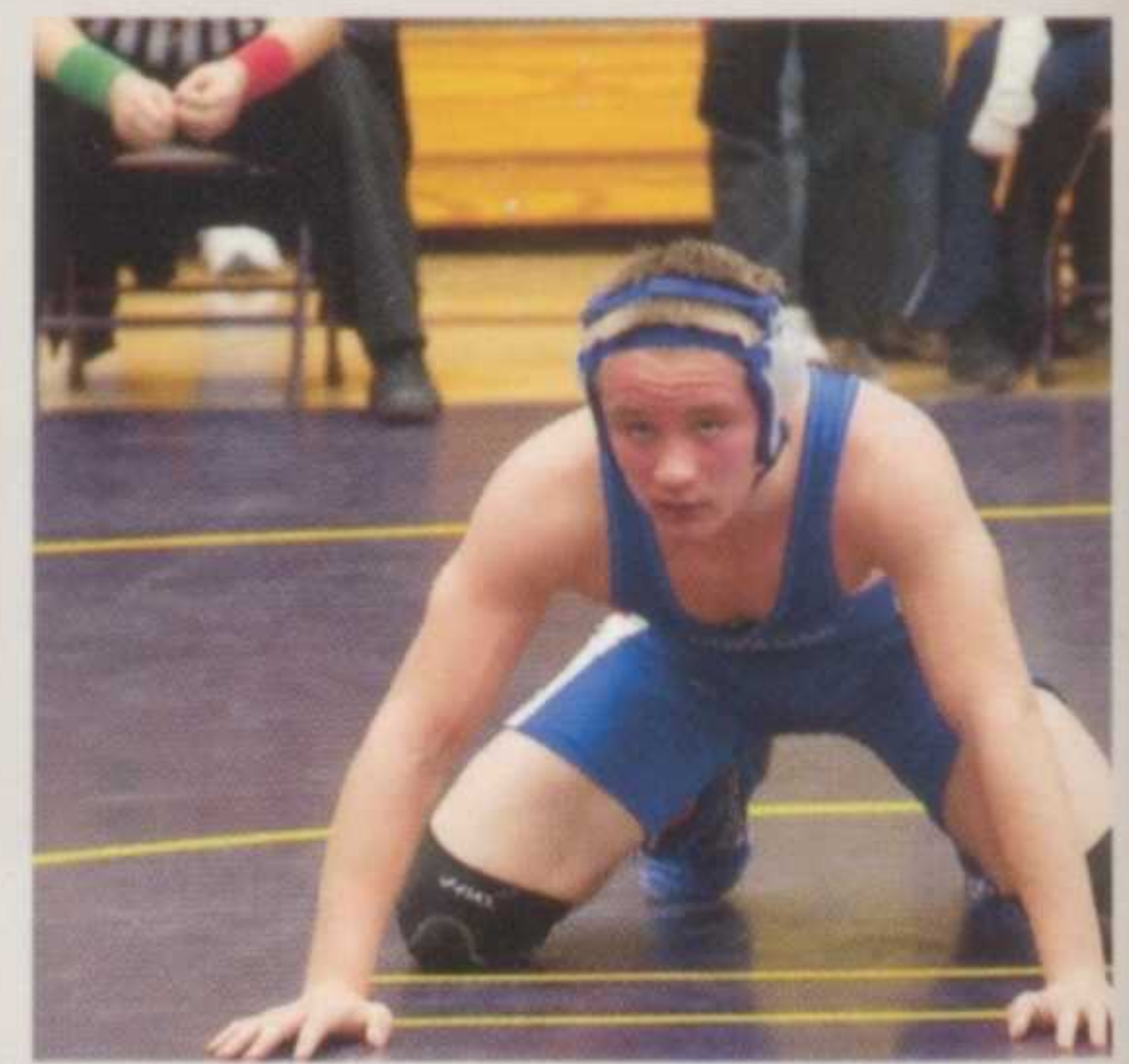
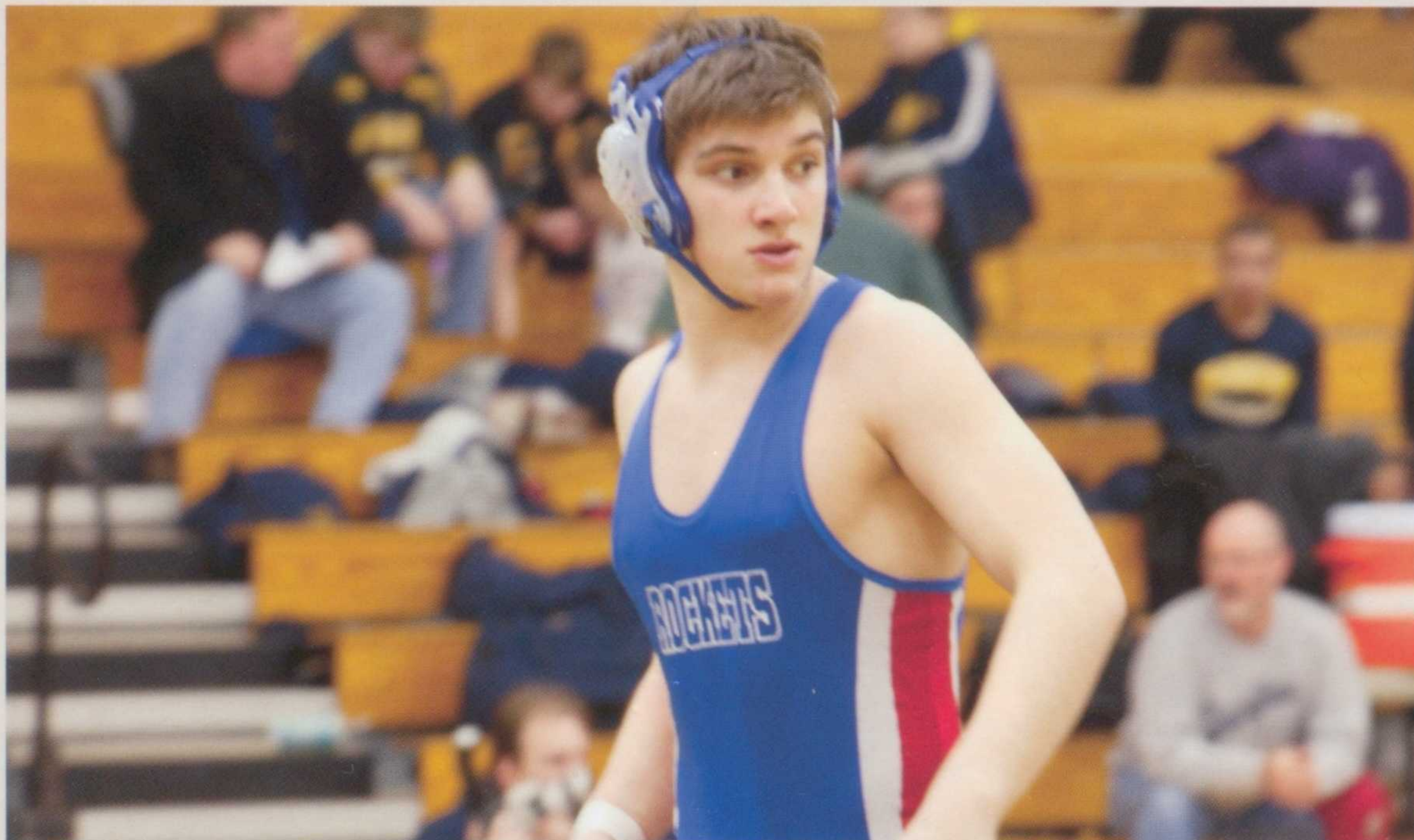
Wrestling

Ruma was eliminated in round three.

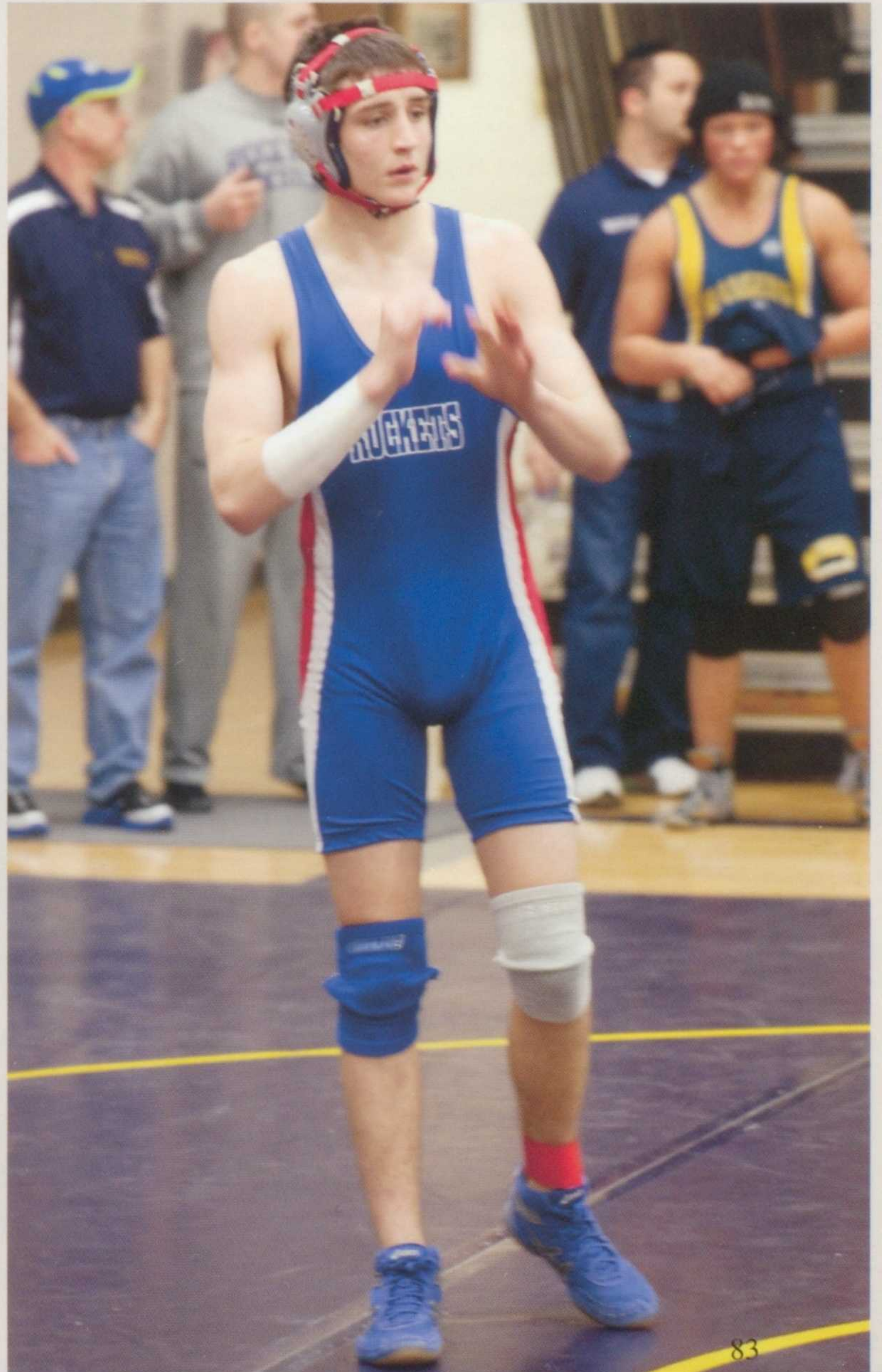

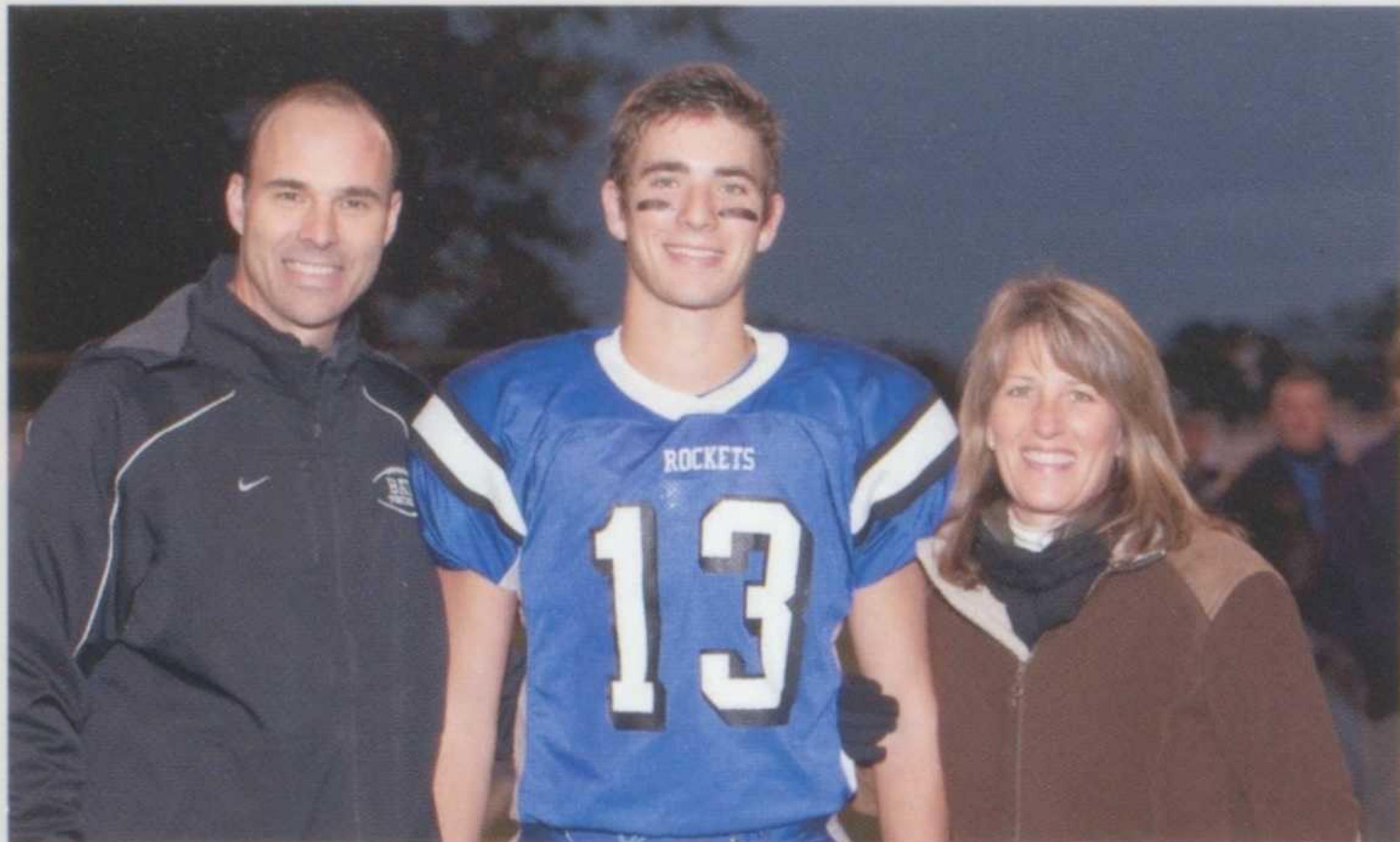

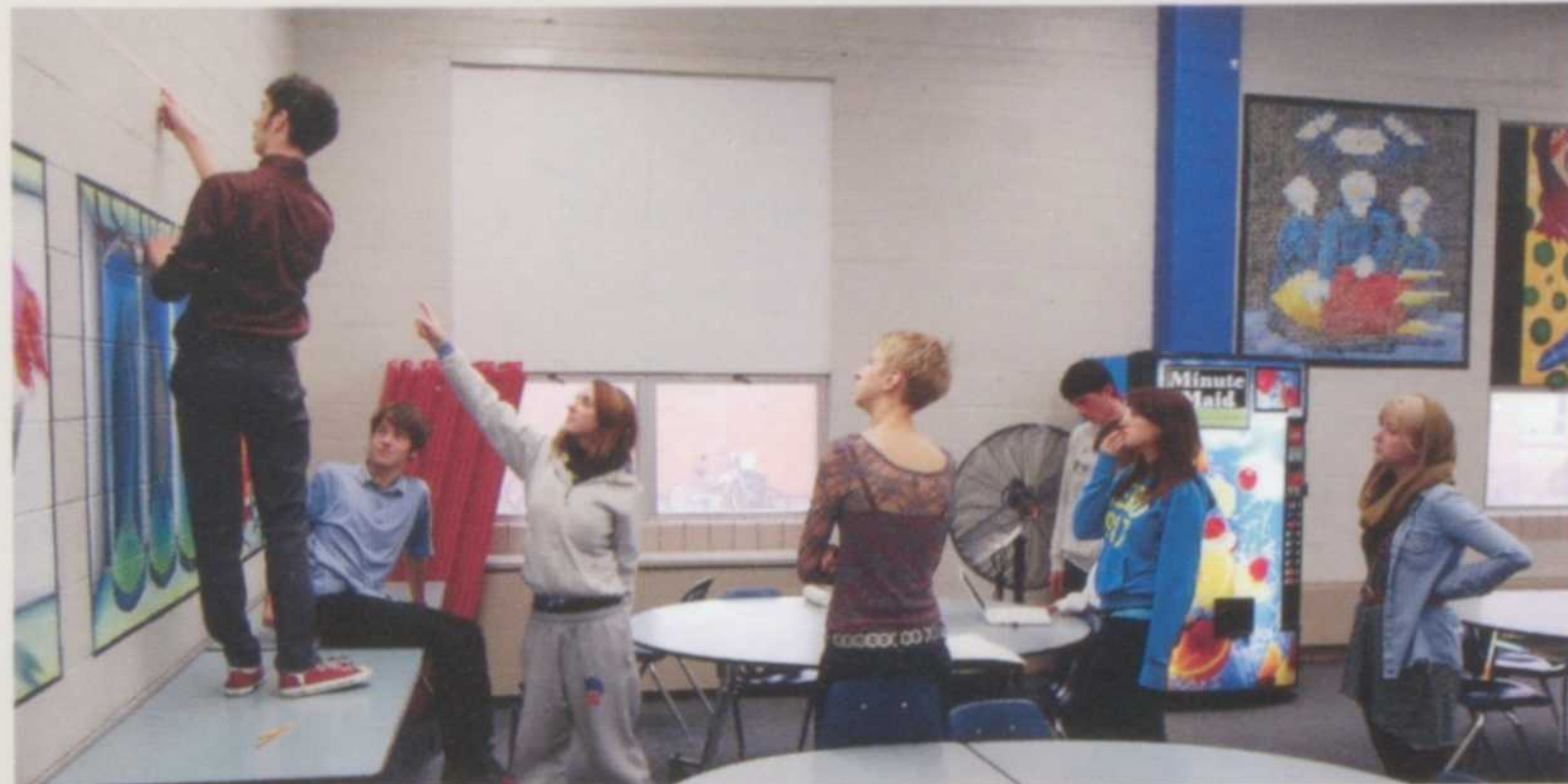

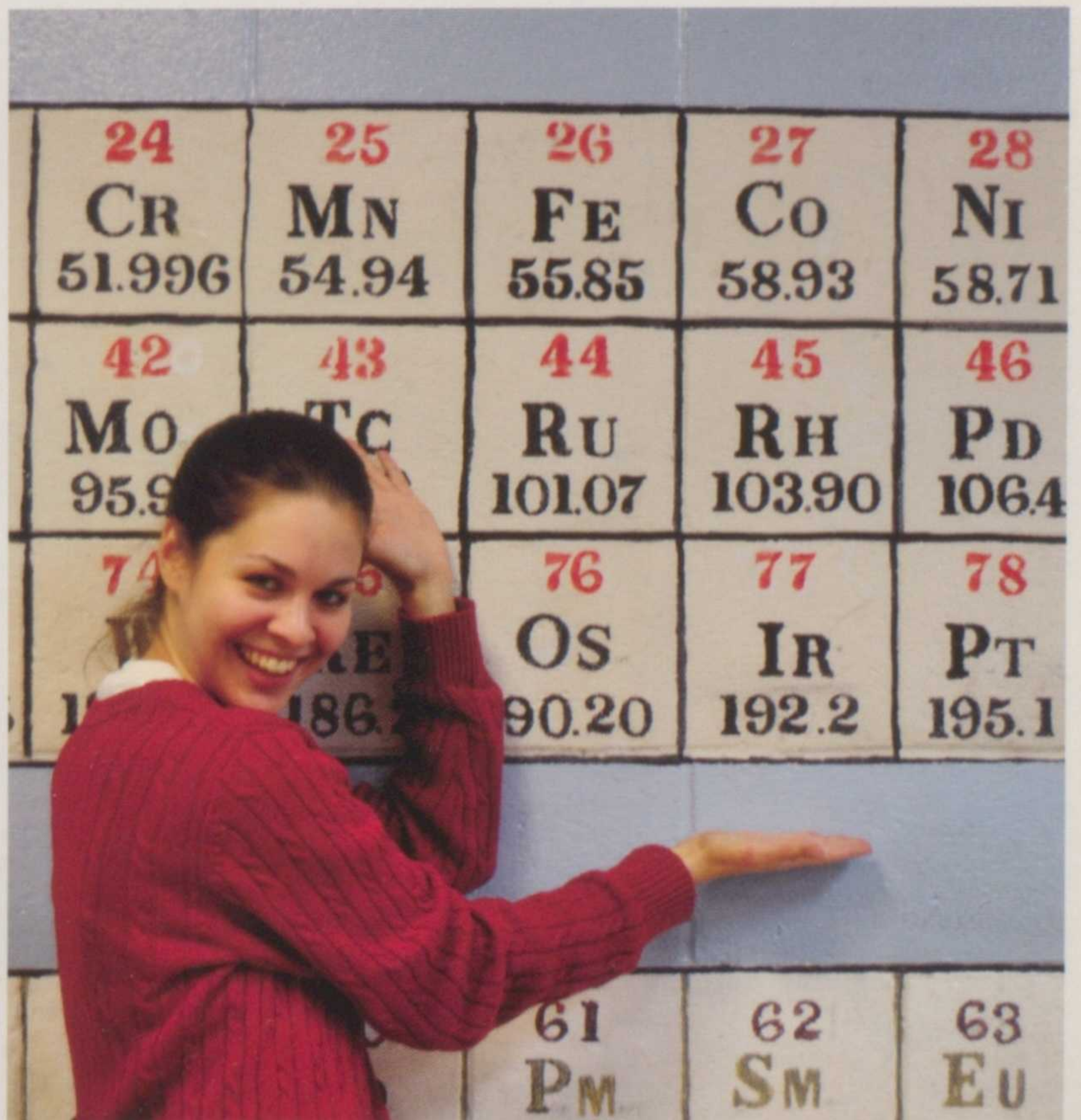

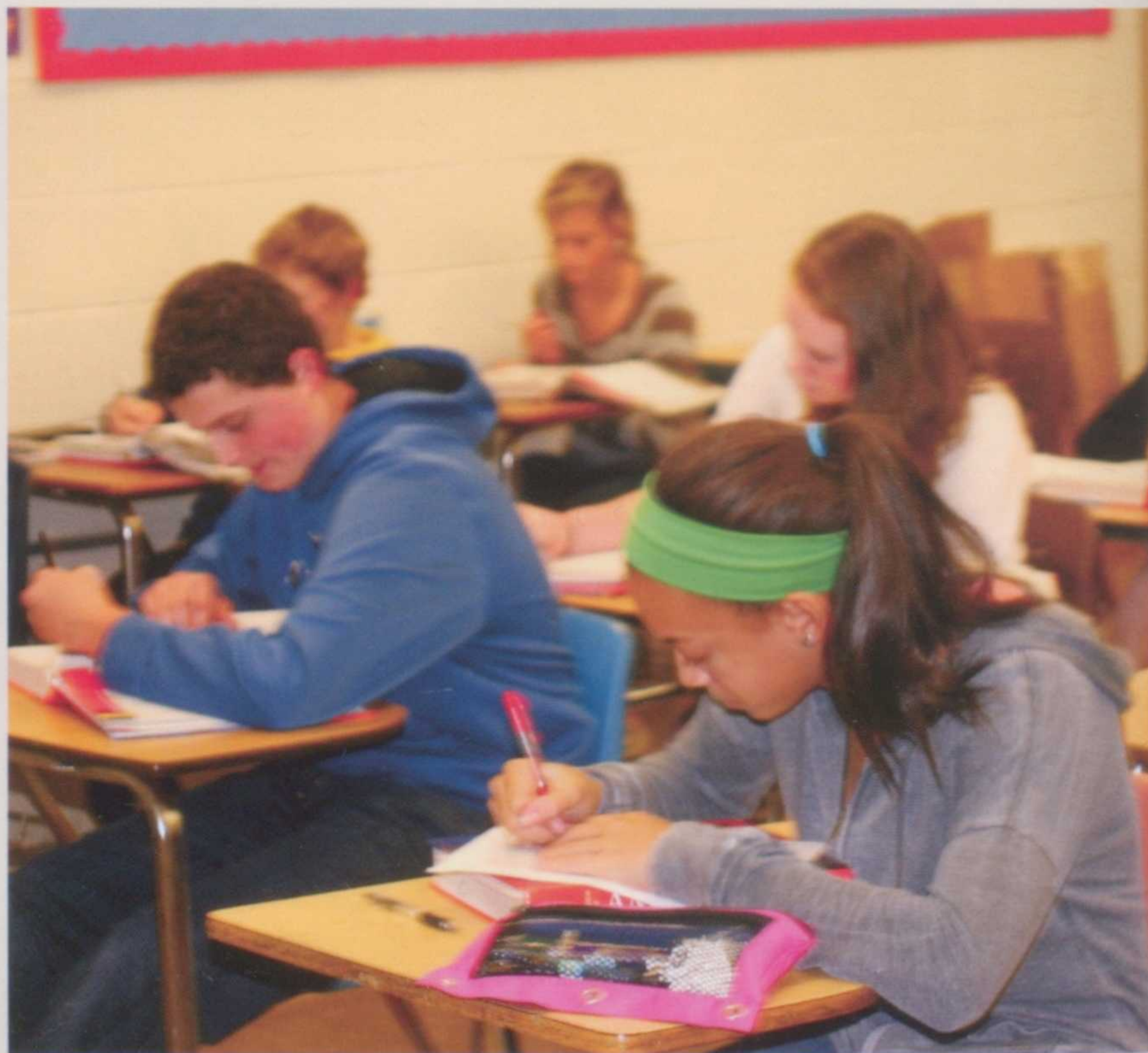
