

Despite a multitude of unforeseen





Coding During a Pandemic:

While we were all adjusting to our new "normal" in quarantine last spring,

Jimmy Bish (!2) was coding.



Although in-person learning was halted last spring, the AP tests were fast approaching, students and teachers alike scrambled to find ways to properly prepare for the exams. For AP Government, the AP exam was reduced to two FRQs, meaning it was crucial for the students to practice and master writing them. That's where Jimmy comes in. "Mr. Grossman usually has us grade each other's FRQs before the AP exam," Jimmy explains, "that way we see how graders think and how they view our work. But he couldn't do that with Google

Does because it shows you who edits or comments what, and that makes people more timid with their criticism." So, Jimmy made a web app for Mr. Grossman to allow the FRQ grading to be completely anonymous. To create the web app, which he simply calls "Anonymous FRQ Grading," Jimmy used different flavors of a programming language called JavaScript. More specifically, the "MEVN" stack; that is, MongoDB, ExpressJS, VueJS, and NodeJS. VueJS was used for the frontend of the website, NodeJS and ExpressJS for the backend, and finally MongoDB for the database. 


Shrek The Musical


















BOYS Soccer



This fall, the Bay High Drama Club put on its first-ever socially distanced play, "Women and War". The play was very different from its Bay High Drama predecessor, Noises Off; despite having a few comedic lines, the play altogether had a far more serious tone as it took the audience through multiple historical wars from various personal lenses. The three central storylines in the show are Helen (Elizabeth Varis, 12) and Buddy (Larson Toil, 10) from World War II, Agnes (Allysa Bleisath, 12) and Johnny (Adam Zeidler, 12) from the Korean War, and Betsy (Marleigh Kraska, 11) and Jack (Cam Grealis, 12) from the Vietnam War, who correspond to each other throughout the performance by letter. The 2021 season was a memorable one, as it ended the Cover dynasty—the most successful wrestling family in Bay history. Mason Cover (12) ended his career with a total of 145 wins and will follow in his brother's footsteps as a D1 wrestler for the prestigious Cleveland State Program. (His brother Matt wrestles for Princeton.) Mason started his high school career wrestling the 130 weight class and concluded his career at 220. This was also the final season of coaching for Mr. Ryan Cover. Mason's success and State Tournament appearance did not eclipse the skill of other wrestlers. Senior Griffin Novotny reached his 100th win this season and now stands at 108 wins. And Quinn Sanfilippo (12) came back from a 2020 shoulder injury to achieve a Bay record for fastest pin ever-7 seconds. Both Griffin and Quinn made it to Districts but lost.


In a school of over 800 students, three guidance counselors work hard to schedule, counsel and instruct the entire student body.






English










History


