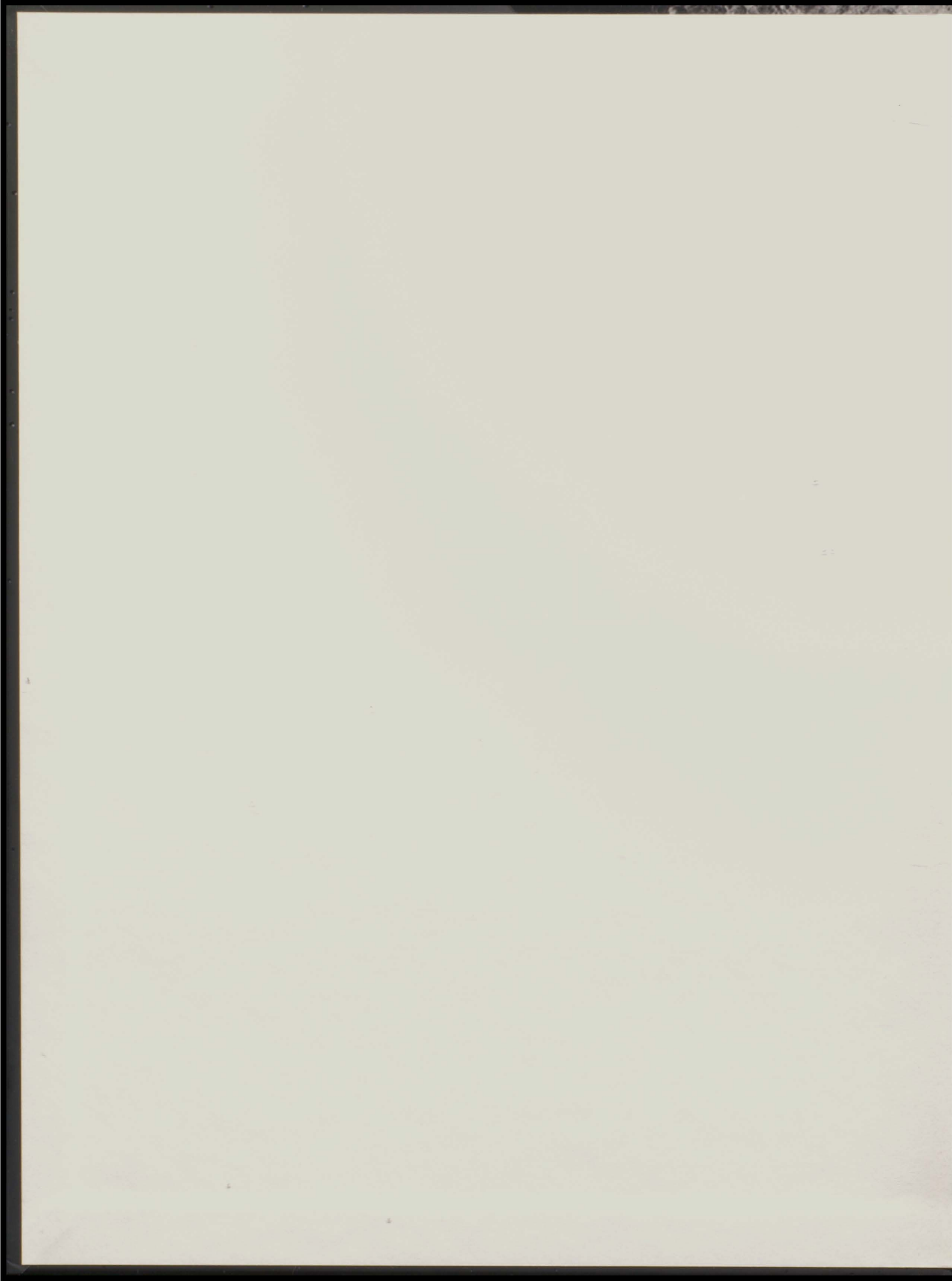
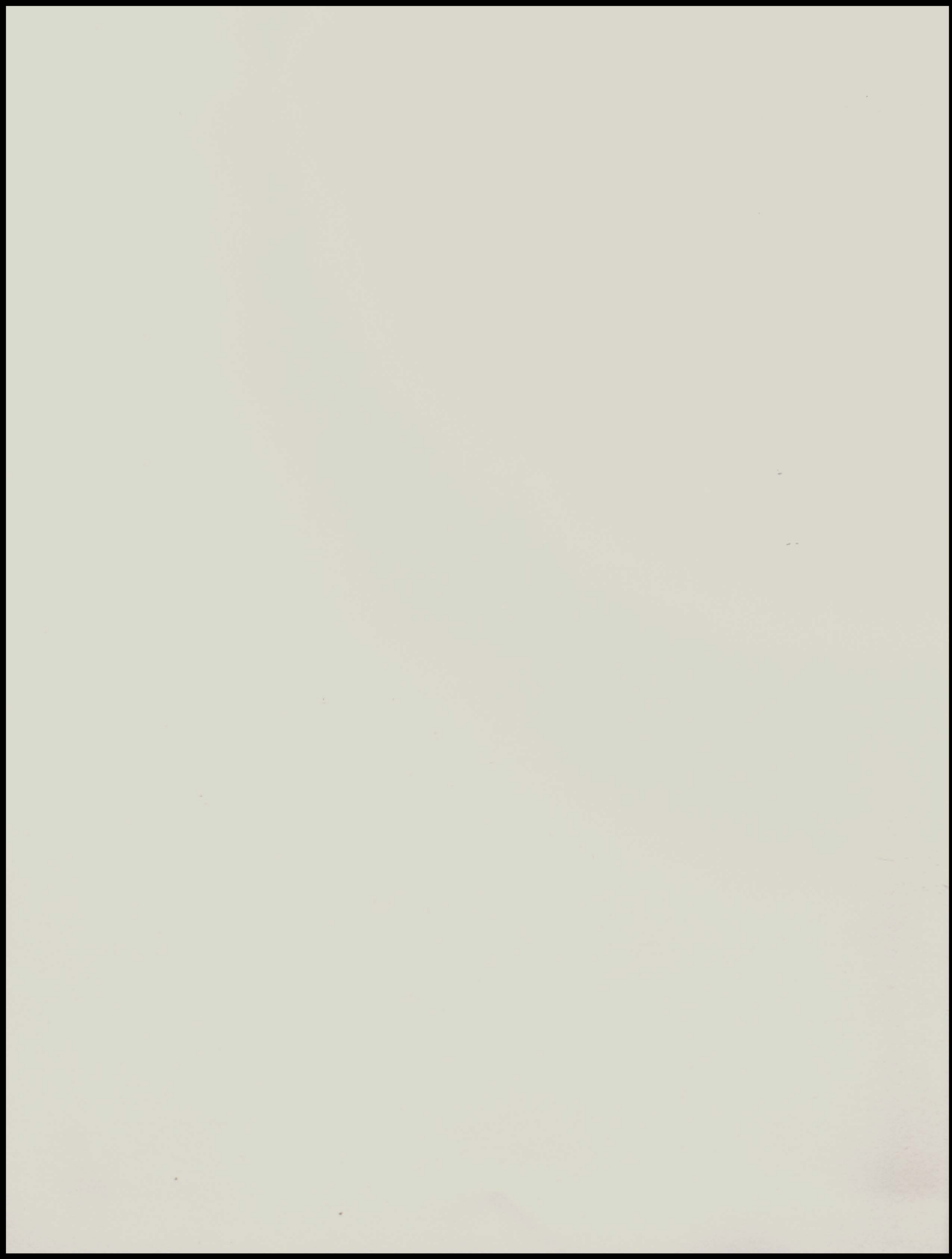

Coding During a Pandemic:

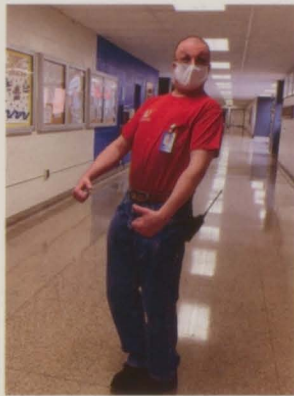
While we were all adjusting to our new "normal" in quarantine last spring, **Jimmy Bish** (12) was coding.



Although in-person learning was halted last spring, the AP tests were fast approaching, and students and teachers alike scrambled to find ways to properly prepare for the exams. For AP Government, the AP exam was reduced to two FRQs, meaning it was crucial for the students to practice and master writing them. That's where Jimmy comes in. "Mr. Grossman usually has us grade each other's FRQs before the AP exam," Jimmy explains, "that way we see how graders think and how they view our work. But he couldn't do that with Google

Docs because it shows you who edits or comments what, and that makes people more timid with their criticism." So, Jimmy made a web app for Mr. Grossman to allow the FRQ grading to be completely anonymous. To create the web app, which he simply calls "Anonymous FRQ Grading," Jimmy used different flavors of a programming language called JavaScript. More specifically, the "MEVN" stack; that is, MongoDB, ExpressJS, VueJS, and NodeJS. VueJS was used for the frontend of the website, NodeJS and ExpressJS for the backend, and finally MongoDB for the database. Thank you, Jimmy, for helping the AP Government students prepare for their exams!

Women And War

"...We lost our first female soldier yesterday - Women and War!"

This fall, the Bay High Drama Club put on its first-ever socially distanced play, "Women and War". The play was very different from its Bay High Drama predecessor, *Noises Off*; despite having a few comedic lines, the play altogether had a far more serious tone as it took the audience through multiple historical wars from various personal lenses. The three central storylines in the show are Helen (**Elizabeth Varis, 12**) and Buddy (**Larson Toil, 10**) from World War II, Agnes (**Allysa Bleisath, 12**) and Johnny (**Adam Zeidler, 12**) from the Korean War, and Betsy (**Marleigh Kraska, 11**) and Jack (**Cam Grealis, 12**) from the Vietnam War, who correspond to each other throughout the performance by letter. Scattered between the letters are various powerful monologues also from different moments in history, including a mother (**Chloe Hoban, 9**) who lost her three sons to the war, a Vietnam soldier (**Sam Brown, 9**) writing to his mother and younger brother, and a female soldier (**Kennedy Thompson, 11**) from present-day who decided to enlist after the events of 9/11.

Besides the amazing performances from the ensemble cast, what especially made "Woman and War" unique was the use of transitions; in between each monologue or letter was a black out accompanied by a sound effect, news audio clip, or song that referenced the next monologue's time period or character. Thanks to the crew, the use of tech in this show truly brought the play all together. Despite only being one act, "Women and War" was a captivating play that deeply resonated with its (socially distanced) audiences.

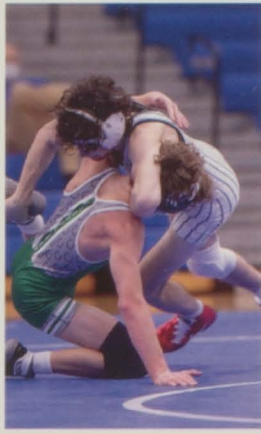
BAY HIGH SCHOOL

Mrs. Beirne typically teaches freshmen and sophomores and the creative writing elective. She is known for her kindness and willingness to aid students.



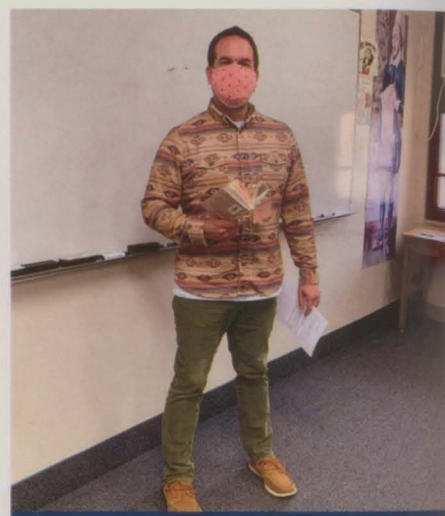

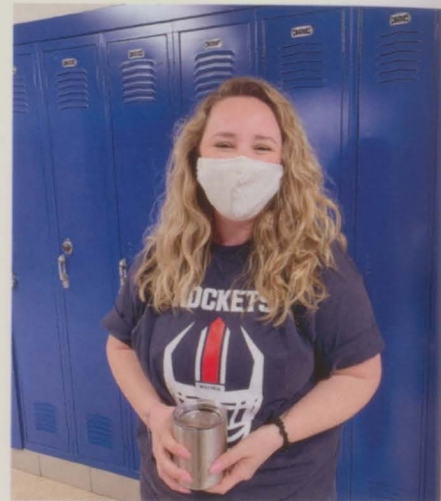
History

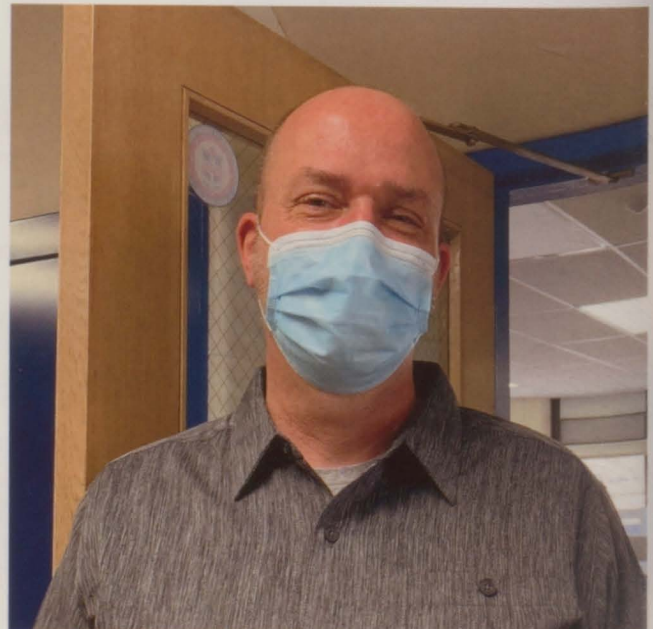

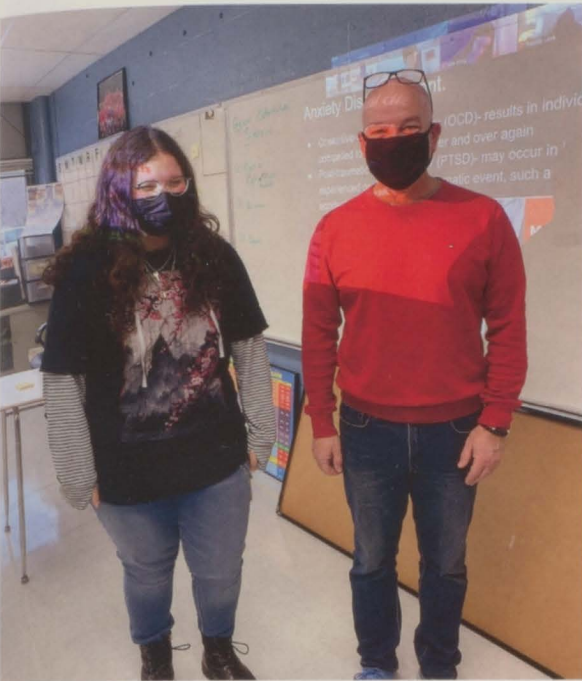

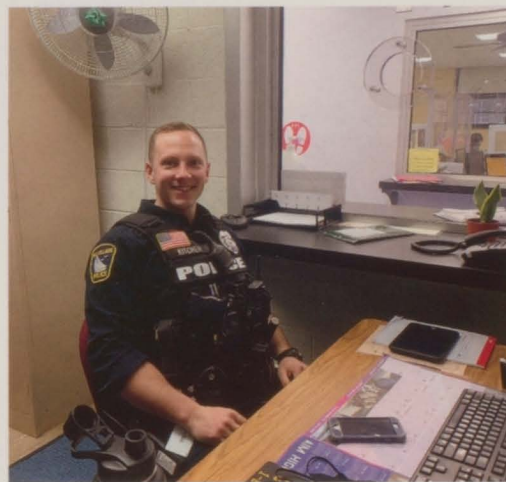


Other Superstars
